2 Levels:

The District increased its growth/improvement rating on its 2008 state-issued district report card by two levels to earn an unprecedented "Excellent" rating!

42,500 Students

Approximately 5,500 employees serve approximately 42,500 students— with enrollment in 2008 at a record high— in 77 schools and several specialized programs.

77% of Teachers

In the 2009 Charleston Teacher Alliance Survey, 77% of teachers said that the Superintendent effectively communicates with teachers.

400 Students

In 2009, the District expanded its early childhood programs by over 400 students.

#1 in the State:

The District leads the state in Palmetto Gold and Silver awards.

\$46 Million

CCSD seniors earned a record \$46 million in college scholarships in 2009.

11 Percentage Points:

From 2007 to 2008, the District's four-year graduation rate increased by 11 percentage points!

PACT, AP, ACT & SAT Scores

In 2008, elementary and middle school students had the highest Proficient-Advanced PACT levels the District has ever had, with CCSD students outscoring their state peers in every subject level and grade level. High school students earned record Advanced Placement (AP), ACT, and SAT scores.
