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I am writing to follow up on my Tuesday night phone call about the County Board's January 26<sup>th</sup> decision to close five schools—Brentwood, Schroder, McClellanville, Fraser, and Charlestowne Academy—as part of the district's *School Redesign* plan. The recommendations, designed to provide your child with improved learning opportunities, will not go into effect until next year. However, in the coming days and months, we will be working with you, constituent boards, school staff and community members to prepare for a successful transition.

As a Fraser parent, your child will have a range of quality school options next year, including possibilities at the brand-new Sanders-Clyde (opening mid-year); seats at Charleston Progressive Academy; and opportunities at Mitchell and Memminger elementary schools. Mitchell and Memminger have new partial magnet themes, and are accepting applications between February 1<sup>st</sup> and March 1<sup>st</sup>. We will work quickly with you, District 20 schools, the constituent board, and community members to clarify your options and communicate with you every step of the way.
