### **Modified Long Term Substitute Teacher**

- This position is posted as a modified long term substitute position.
- Applicants hired for these positions will be offered temporary employment as a long term substitute for the remainder of the 2009-2010 school year. This is a temporary employment position and is therefore considered at-will and employment can be terminated by either the employee or employer for any or no reason.
- After the completion of the school year, the employee may or may not be offered a contract for the 10-11 school year based on the needs of the District.
- Certified teachers hired for these positions will be subject to the established Charleston County School District interview and clearance standards.
- Applicants hired under this process will be paid a daily rate based on their degree and experience as noted on their SC teaching certificate. Applicants who accept one of these positions will be paid based solely on the actual days worked during a pay period.
- These positions are not eligible for benefits (the applicants can opt in/out of State Retirement).
