








### Virtual Learning Expectations

•Participate and be present for class


#### **Expectation of Voice**

To create an account:


- 1. Go to http://ccsdschools.instructure.com/register from website

You will enter a pairing code for your child.


Pairing code

You only need to create one account, you can add multiple codes for multiple children.











## Where Do I Find the Pairing Code?

- > You may observe multiple children. Follow the directions on slides 7 and 8 to observe more scholars.




