

BOT Highlights for June 25, 2018 Board of Trustees Meeting

Superintendent's Evaluation

The Board approved the superintendent's evaluation process, which will be effective for the 2018-19 school year. The Board will establish agreed-upon goals for which the superintendent will be evaluated by August, there will be a mid-year progress review at the end of the first semester (middle of January), and there will be a year-end, summative evaluation in July that includes a summer of progress towards accomplishing goal, strategic priorities, and achievement indicators. The superintendent will be responsible for providing student data summaries throughout the school year, as the results become available.

Policy FF- Naming of Facilities and Policy DJBA - Revenue Enhancing Contracts (second reading) (Jeff Borowy)

The Board passed the second reading of revisions to Policies FF and DJBA, which would allow the Board of Trustees and the District to pursue "Revenue Enhancing Contracts" for facilities.

Any contract the District would pursue that would name a facility will still require Board of Trustees approval.

Policy IKFC - Employability Credential

The Board approved the creation (first reading) of Policy IKFC, which will outline the requirements for the South Carolina High School Credential (SCHSC). The SCHSC will be a career-based educational program that will provide opportunities for students with disabilities to obtain work skills. The program is expected to improve a student's ability to gain meaningful employment after graduating high school.

CCSD has offered its own District Credential in previous years, but it was only available to students with disabilities in Charleston County. The policy will allow students to gain access to a uniform, state-recognized employability credential upon completion of the course of study. The District's Department of Exceptional Children collaborated with the Departments of Career and Technology Education and Guidance to create this proposal.
