North Charleston High School Projected HSAP Pass Rates 2012

Based on students who will take HSAP for the first time in April 2012 who had Winter 2012 MAP scores.

Notes:

- Only 106 reading MAP scores and 107 math MAP scores were available for the 135 students who are on the list as first time HSAP takers.
- Students who were not enrolled at NCHS as of the 45th day may be included in this analysis, but do not count in the state calculations.
- Students who attend program schools were not included in this analysis, but will count in the state calculations.

Projected math pass rate = 64.7% (Last year = 51.6%)

Projected ELA pass rate = 71.2% (Last year = 64.9%)

Projected pass rate both subjects = **55.45%** (Last year = 48.2%)

Projected EOC Performance Algebra I and English I

- Based on MAP scores the projected pass rate for students who will take the Algebra I End of Course test is 68.44%
- Based on MAP scores the projected pass rate for students who will take the English I End of Course test is 60.5%
