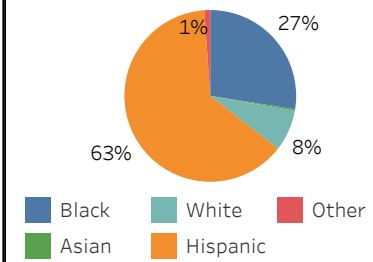

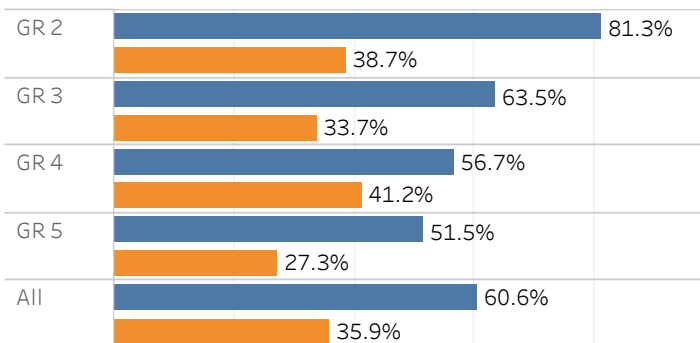

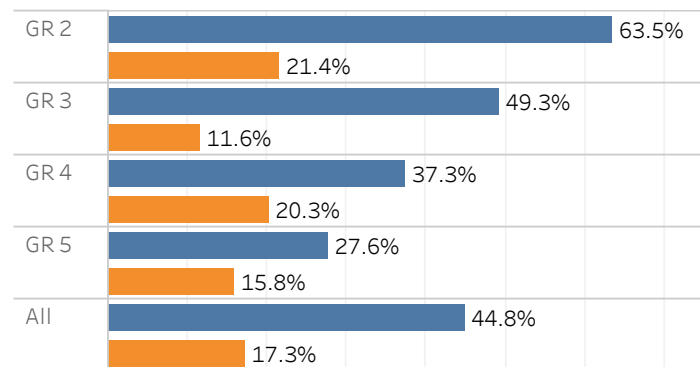

### Growth: MAP Reading 2015-16

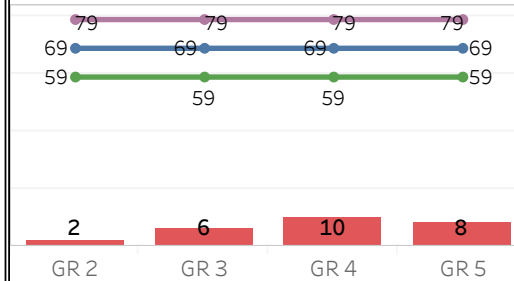


### Growth: MAP Math 2015-16

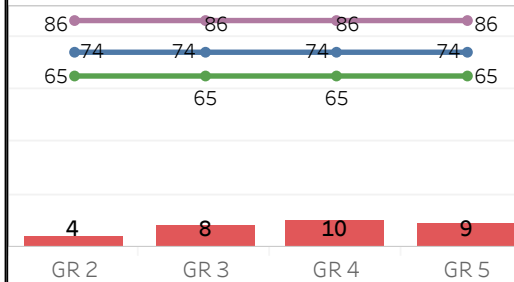

### MAP Fall 2016 Math Proficiency Grade Level Percentile Rank

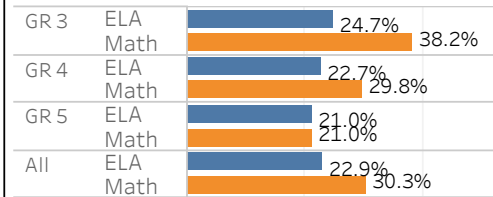

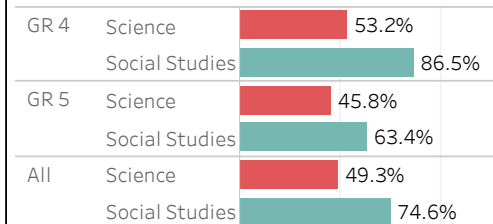

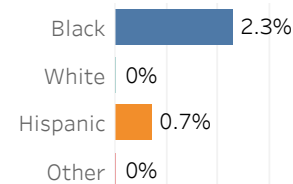
