**This amendment was issued to answer questions received, provide latest 4 manifests, provided current contract tabulation sheet, and provide an updated bid schedule.**

1. Can I get the pricing page from the vendor that has the contract now for the Disposal of Hazardous Waste.

**Answer: See attached last 4 redacted invoices.**

2. I work for Lhoist North America, which is a chemical company based out in Fort Worth, TX. I just came across your bid for chemicals and I am interested to know the annual average consumption of "Calcium Hydroxide", that you guys use.

**Answer: No Calcium hydroxide other than small lab pack quantities.**

3. Can you provide a list of schools and/or locations along with addresses that may require pickup and disposal of chemicals?

**Answer: Pickup at schools are very rare, and it may vary with any school in the district, if necessary.**

4. Will the frequency of service be as needed or scheduled? If scheduled, what is the schedule frequency?

**Answer: Will be as needed, usually on a quarterly basis.**

5. Will there be any unknown or unlabeled chemicals offered for disposal?

**Answer: Yes**

6. Will there be any gas cylinders offered for disposal?

**Answer: Yes, but rarely**

7. Will there be any unknown or unlabeled gas cylinders offered for disposal?

**Answer: No**

8. Will there be any EPA listed herbicides/pesticides offered for disposal?

**Answer: Yes, but rarely**

9. Will there be any PCB (poly chlorinated byphenyls containing materials offered for disposal?

**Answer: Historically No.**

10. Will there be any shock sensitive or explosive materials requiring deactivation prior to disposal offered?

**Answer: No**

11. Will there be any biological and or medical waste offered for disposal?

**Answer: Yes, biological, and No medical**

12. What has been the historic pickup frequency, one per year, quarterly, monthly?

**Answer: Usually 3 times per year**

13. Please provide an average or approximate volume per pickup you have historically generated.

**Answer: See attached last 4 redacted invoices.**

14. The solicitation identifies most of the material will be removed from 3999 Bridge View Drive, North Charleston, SC; how often have pickups been done at other locations in the last two years if any?

**Answer: One to two pickups per year at other locations**

15. Please supply disposal invoices, with accompanying manifest copies for the 4 most recent disposal removal projects.

**Answer: See attached last 4 redacted invoices.**

16. Before the vendor is scheduled to arrive on-site, does the generating location compile and submit an inventory of material they need disposed? If so, please send all the inventory sheets submitted to your disposal vendor in the past year.

17. Is any material generated at any site in bulk quantity (non-labpack)? Ex. Motor oil poured up into 55 gallon drums? Antifreeze poured up into 55 gallon drums? Flammable lab solvents poured up into 30 or 55 gallon drums? If yes what materials and size of containers are generated?

18. Universal waste such a fluorescent lamps, batteries or electronics are not identified in the Scope of Work, will these items be covered by this contract and if so which items?

**Answer: Yes. All of the above mentioned, but not limited to just those items.**

19. To quote you more accurately, please expand the lines to be quoted to multiple drum sizes per DOT Hazardous class.

**Answer: Please see attached updated Bid Form**

20. Including all types of material in one price point will force the contractor to price worse case and would increase your overall costs. Each DOT Hazard class has specific disposal costs. A list of suggested categories is identified below

Flammable liquid lab pack per 5 gal pail, per 15 gal drum, per 30 gal drum, per 55 gal drum  
Corrosive lab pack “  
Toxic material lab pack “  
Oxidizing material lab pack “  
Non-regulated lab packs “  
Reactive material lab pack 5 gal pail  
Mercury devices and compounds in lab pack 5 gal Pail  
On-Site remote opening/stabilization of shock sensitive material as a lump sum charge per project.  
Disposal of Shock Sensitive material – On Site stabilized by Tradebe personnel. 1 lb of material packed in a 5 gallon pail.

21. Labor is very difficult to estimate per container, in order to insure you are billed an accurate amount for labor please modify the labor rate to include all contractor onsite time.

22. To provide accurate pricing for each line item, we would like to kindly ask for a copy of the five most recent invoices, the most recent awarded bid tabulation for these services, and a copy of the current contract pricing.

23. Is there a prequalification process to become an approved vendor for CCSD?

**Answer: Vendor must complete a CCSD Vendor ID Form and provide a current W9 Form**

24. Does CCSD require a remote opening capability for any of the listed chemicals?

**Answer: Normally no, but may be required in case of a spill.**

25. How many other locations may these materials need to be picked up from? What are the distances of these locations from the Bridgeview address?

**Answer: Locations may vary, usually one or two locations per year. Cannot determine distance; Charleston County is located on South Carolina's southeastern coast and covers an area of 1,357 square miles and has a 100-mile coastline along the Atlantic Ocean.**

26. What is the response time requirements for any spills?

**Answer: 24 to 48 hours. Usually CCSD will handle emergency spills.**

27. One of the requirements is to provide safety barricades, temporary walks and signals at no additional cost. Is this requirement in relation to spill response and only if needed?

**Answer: Yes, and only if required**

28. Is the list of Chemicals provided a current inventory of the districts chemicals or is it a representation of chemicals that have been disposed of by the district?

**Answer: A representation of chemicals that have been disposed of by the district. See attached last 4 redacted invoices.**

29. Will a list of all 2017 manifests be supplied to us?

**Answer: No. See attached last 4 redacted invoices.**

30. Will you make 2017 waste volumes available?

**Answer: No. See attached last 4 redacted invoices.**

31. Should all labor, materials, trans and disposal be included in each 55gal drum rate?

**Answer: Yes, and please see attached updated Bid Form**

32. Based on the list, with varying disposal costs for different chemicals, how are the costs to be broken down in order to provide an accurate estimate?

**Answer: Please see attached updated Bid Form**

33. Will we be able to make a site visit?

34. Can we subcontract out the transportation of explosives and shock sensitive materials?

**Answer: Yes. Please see \*Note below**

\*Note: Once our Hazardous Waste Shed is full, CCSD contacts the current vendor to schedule a site visit. The vendor responds with 7-10 business days to arrive on site. The vendor provides consolidating materials (i.e. pallets, drums, boxes, etc) prior to arrival. Once on site, the vendor spends 1-2 days on site consolidating the chemicals, paint, biological specimens, universal waste (but not limited to mentioned list). Once they complete consolidation, they coordinate the pick-up via current vendor truck transport. When the transport truck arrives, CCSD's warehouse staff will assist in loading the consolidated pallets.
