I. Call to Order:

The board meeting was called to order at 4:02 p.m. by Daron Calhoun.

Joy Brown moved, with a second by Janie Daniel, to approve the meeting minutes for the March 2, 2022, meeting. The motion passed 3-0.

8.55.21 – A motion was made by Rodney Lewis, seconded by Joy Brown, to allow student 8.55.21 to return to school on strict board probation for the remainder of the school year. As part of the probation, the student will be required to check his phone into the office at the start of the school day and retrieve it at the end of the school day. The motion passed 5-0.

8.57.21 – A motion was made by Joy Brown, seconded by Janie Daniels, to place student 8.57.21 at Turning Point Academy for a minimum stay of 30 days on strict board probation. The student will remain on strict board probation for the remainder of the school year. The motion passed 5-0.

8.56.21 – A motion was made by David Bell, seconded by Joy Brown, to expel student 8.56.21 from CE Williams Middle School and Charleston County School District, with services, for the remainder of the 2021-2022 school year. The motion passed 4-0.
