# I. Welcome/Purpose:

The meeting was called to order at 5:35 p.m. by Carla Gadson. Board Chair, C. Gadson, then explained the purpose of the rezoning workshop.

# II. Review of Attendance Lines Draft Proposals & Discussion

The Office of Planning and Real Estate (Angela Barnette, Director) presented options of rezoning several schools in the upper corridor of Dorchester Road, as well as the two neighborhood high schools that serve the students of District 4.

# a. District 4 Elementary Schools

The Board looked at the attendance lines for Lambs, Hunley Park, and Goodwin Elementary. The main purpose of this discussion and review is so to alleviate schools that are currently at capacity, as well as eliminate students from passing one school to attend another. There was also discussion concerning single neighborhoods where children attend multiple schools.

# b. District 4 High Schools

The Board reviewed the attendance zones and current capacities for Stall and North Charleston high schools. Rezoning options were presented as Stall is currently over capacity (107%) while North Charleston is under capacity (70%).

# III. Closing:

Board members agreed that public meetings would need to be held in September 2021 to inform the families of the potentially affected areas. Three meetings will be held and the locations will be Lambs Elementary, Stall High School, and North Charleston High. The meeting ended at 6:15pm.
