I. Call to Order:

David Bell moved, with a second by Jennifer Osteen, to assign student 8.65.19 to the District's Turning Point Academy for a minimum stay of 45 days on strict board probation for the 2020-2021 school year. If the student cannot successfully compete TPA, the student will be assigned to Daniel Jenkins Academy until successful completion of the program. If the student is accepted into Clark Academy before the start of the school year, the student is allowed to attend Clark in lieu of the TPA placement, but will remain on board probation for the 2020-2021 school year. The motion passed 4-0.

Cynthia Anderson moved, with a second by David Bell, to refer student 8.68.19 to the school-based IEP team for alternative placement consideration. The motion passed 4-0.
