### I. Call to Order & Moment of Silence:

The board meeting was called to order at 5:46 p.m. by the Board Chair, Katy Calloway, followed by a moment of silence and the Pledge of Allegiance.

#### B. Hardship Student Transfer Request

A motion was made by Katy Calloway, seconded by Cynthia Smalls, to approve the hardship transfer for student V-B1 for the remainder of the 2021-2022 school year. The motion passed 5-0.

A motion was made by Katy Calloway, seconded by Cynthia Smalls, to approve the hardship transfer for student V-B2 for the remainder of the 2021-2022 school year. The motion passed 5-0.

# VIII. <u>District Updates:</u>

Dr. Swearingen shared the following updates on District 3 Schools:

### **Harbor View Elementary**

- New turf put in this summer.
- Received math specialist and interventionist through ESSER funds.

### ♣ James Island Elementary

- Certified teacher in Science lab. All K-5 students receive instruction in Science lab.
- Received 4, 70-inch monitors that are being used in the hallways, front office and cafeteria.
- Head Start classes outfitted with new furniture and manipulative.
- School-based news teams are performing live for students every morning.

# ♣ Murray LaSaine Elementary

- ESSER funds used to higher math coach who will do math intervention, professional development and coaching, and parent education.
- School was placed on two week of virtual instruction due to COVID numbers and quarantine. *Return to in person instruction on September 16*, 2021.
- New offerings CTE for adolescent students this year. English 1 and Algebra is being offered to 8<sup>th</sup> graders that qualify.

### ♣ Stiles Point Elementary

- ESSER funds used to fund a full time reading and math interventionist this school year.
- Media center will be getting a redesign this fall-complete with new furniture and other updates to help us better utilize the space.
- Stiles Point morning show is being daily using state of the art equipment. They are enjoying the creativity of having an entire "green screen wall: on which to project their backgrounds.
- PTA just concluded the fall Boosterthon fundraiser with the support of parents and community. The PTA far surpassed its initial donation goal.

#### Camp Road Middle

- ESSER funds used for a certified teacher to teach reading intervention and math intervention classes to students that are struggling.
- Exceeded projected enrollment and will be able to hire an additional teacher and plan to offer additional Career and Technology (CTE) classes for students during related arts.

- Ms. Calloway shared that Ms. Smalls secured a huge donation of hand sanitizer and wipes that they went around delivering to churches and schools from James Island to Hanahan.
- Mask mandate going into effect next week.

  Calloway encouraged community members to reach out to District 3 board members to share input.

#### Murray LaSaine - Dr. George Tempel

- The PTO will have a campaign in October to increase funds.
- Nearly all children were complying with board mask requirement.

• PTO Mystery Science received \$800 from PTO organization.

### **James Island Elementary - Cynthia Smalls**

School is full. Ms. Gregory is still without an assistant principal. Dr. Swearingen provided clarification on capacity requirements for a school to obtain an Assistant Principal.

Dr. Tempel shared that James Island Elementary and Murray LaSaine Elementary both received notebooks, crayons and pencils from Mrs. Carol Tempel.
