Regular Board Meeting Minutes

Thursday, October 21, 2021

I. Call to Order:

The board meeting was called to order at 5:00 p.m. by Board Chair, Mr. Rodney Lewis.

II. Adoption of Agenda:

David Bell moved, seconded by Joy Brown, to adopt the agenda as written. The motion passed 4-0.

III. Approval of Minutes:

Daron Calhoun moved, with a second by Joy Brown, to approve the meeting minutes for the October 7th meeting as written. The motion passed 4-0.
