**I. Call to Order:**

The board meeting was called to order at 5:02 p.m. by the Board Chair, George Tempel.

**II. Adoption of Agenda:**

Cynthia Smalls moved, with a second by George Tempel, to go into Executive Session. The motion passed 3-0.

**A. Discipline Hearing**
