I. Call to Order:

The board meeting was called to order at 4:34 p.m. by Board Chair, Mr. Rodney Lewis.

II. Adoption of Agenda:

Janie Daniels moved, seconded by David Bell, to adopt the agenda as written. The motion passed 5-0.

III. Approval of Minutes:

Joy Brown moved, with a second by David Bell, to approve the meeting minutes for the October 21st and October 28th, meetings as written. The motion passed 5-0.

8.12.21 – A motion as made by Rodney Lewis, seconded by David Bell, to place student 8.12.21 in Turning Point Academy for a minimum stay of 45 days and remain on strict board probation for the 2021-2022 school year. The motion passed 5-0.

Mr. Bell excused himself from the meeting as he was not feeling well.

8.13.21 – A motion was made by Daron Calhoun, seconded by Janie Daniels, to allow student 8.13.21 to return to school on strict board probation for the remainder of the school year. The motion passed 4-0.
