**I. Call to Order, Invocation/Moment of Silence, and Pledge of Allegiance:**

**VI. Vote on Executive Session Items:**

**A. Discipline Hearings**

- a. A motion was made by J. Wilson, seconded by M. Garnett, to have student 5.38 return to school on strict Board probation for the remainder of the school year. Student will also be required to write a paper on a famous king, which is due to the Board by the last regular meeting of the 2021-2022 school year. The motion passed 3-0.
- b. A motion was made by M. Garnett, seconded by C. Collins, to have student 5.39 return to school on strict Board probation for the remainder of the school year. A second motion was made to have the student placed at Daniel Jenkins Academy until successful completion of the program. The student will also be on Board probation for the remainder of the school year. The motion to return to school passed 3-2 (J. Wilson and L. Fyall opposed).
- c. A motion was made by M. Garnett, seconded by C. Collins, to have student 5.40 to have the student sent to Turning Point Academy for a minimum stay of 30 days on strict Board probation. A second motion was made by J. Wilson, seconded by L. Fyall, to have the student placed at Daniel Jenkins Academy until successful completion of the program. The student will also be on Board probation for the remainder of the school year. The second motion passed 3-0 (Gadson and Collins opposed). This case was heard in absentia.
- d. A motion was made by J. Wilson, seconded by M. Garnett, to have student 5.41 return to school on strict Board probation for the remainder of the school year. The motion passed 5-0.

- e. A motion was made by J. Wilson, seconded by C. Collins, to have student 5.42 return to school on strict Board probation for the remainder of the school year. The motion passed 5-0.
