 - 2. An Elementary and Secondary School Emergency Relief fund update was given during the Board meeting with the focus was on wrap-around services school funding based on the percentage of those reading below grade level.

 - 1. There is an after school tutorial program four days a week for students that provides extra help in math, reading, and science.

 - 3. The new program Reset Academic Olympics begins 4th quarter.
 - 4. Black History program took place on March 28.

 - 4. Despite transportation issues, student participation in sports is remarkable.
