

Alcohol & other Drugs Alternative Programs for Teens K-12th PDP

The use, possession, and distribution of illegal substances (alcohol, tobacco, drugs, or other illegal substances), products used to create these substances, and/or the possession of paraphernalia related to an illegal substance is unacceptable and prohibited, for any student (regardless of age) to have on a school campus or while attending a school sponsored event. Students found in violation of the Charleston County School District (CCSD) Progressive Discipline Plan will be held accountable as outlined below. In addition to a school administrator, the school's Security Resource Officer (SRO) will confiscate all items as evidence to the violation that occurred and complete a police incident report(as applicable). For parents or school administrators who may have a concern about a student's exposure, usage, or activity with drugs, alcohol, or tobacco you are encouraged to visit the ADAPT Resource page for prevention and intervention support groups and programs that may be available to you, as well as, connecting with your student's school counselor for additional suggestions and resources.

The listed infractions include interventions that should be used at each occurrence; however the school administrator has discretion on the number of days he or she assigns for an ISS or OSS (not exceeding the number of days listed), as well as if the student is to be referred to DAP/CB for further disciplinary actions. Examples of when you would consider an alternative consequence than the ones provided would be for extenuating student circumstances, IEP compliance, and/or awaiting the results of an investigation.

3	580 Drug Possession 2 (i.e., THC/Delta 8 vape pens with liquid, edibles, marijuana bagged, marijuana rolled, illegal pills, or concealed and any other illegal drug substances)	Possession of an illegal substance represented as drugs, and/or a mood-altering substance (prescription medication). Students under the influence or possession of drugs who admitted to smoking, possessing, or ingesting drugs on campus/school/district sponsored events. This should be used for students who used, ingested, or possessed drugs while on campus/school/district sponsored events.(the student who provided the drugs should be coded for a 570 Drug Distribution). 3	570 Drug Distribution	It is unlawful for any person (1) to manufacture, distribute, dispense, deliver, or purchase; or to aid, abet, attempt, or conspire to manufacture, distribute, dispense, deliver, or purchase; or to possess with intent to manufacture, distribute, dispense, deliver, or purchase a controlled substance and (2) to create, distribute, dispense, deliver, or purchase; or to aid, abet, attempt, or conspire to create, distribute, dispense, deliver, or purchase; or to possess with intent to distribute, dispense, deliver, or purchase a counterfeit substance. 2	575 Drug Usage	Sell, The use or being under the influence of an illegal substance; solicitation of any chemical compound or material which is categorically not permitted on school grounds or at school related activities such as prescription or nonprescription medication; being under the influence of unauthorized legal or any illegal substances. This should only be used for students who come to school/school activity under the influence.

3	585 Drug Paraphernalia	Paraphernalia as any instrument, device, article, or contrivance used, designed for use, or intended for use in ingesting, smoking, administering, manufacturing, or preparing a controlled substance and does not include cigarette papers and tobacco pipes but includes, but is not limited to: (a) metal, wooden, acrylic, glass, stone, plastic, or ceramic marijuana or hashish pipes with or without screens, permanent screens, hashish heads, or punctured metal bowls; (b) water pipes designed for use or intended to use with marijuana, hashish, hashish oil, or cocaine; (c) carburetion tubes and devices; (d) smoking and carburetion masks; (e) roach clips; (f) separation gins designed for use or intended for use in cleaning marijuana; (g) cocaine spoons and vials; (h) chamber pipes; (i) carburetor pipes; (j) electric pipes; (k) air-driven pipes; (l) chilams; (m) bongs; (n) ice pipes or chillers. Sell, The use or being under the influence of an illegal substance; solicitation of any chemical compound or material which is categorically not permitted on school grounds or at school related activities such as prescription or nonprescription medication; being under the influence of unauthorized legal or any illegal substances. 3	580 Drug Possession 1 (i.e., THC pods, drug residue, roaches)	Possession of an illegal substance represented as drugs, and/or a mood-altering substance (prescription medication). This code should only be selected for items of little substance and when students have not used/distributed the items to others.
