PROJECT UPDATE 1/11/2018

This project is complete. Carolina Park Elementary is roughly 127,000 square feet and designed to accommodate 900 students initially, with the potential for additional classrooms to increase the capacity to 1200 students, if needed.

The new facility will include eight pre-k and kindergarten classrooms, 10 first grade classrooms, nine second grade classrooms, nine third grade classrooms, five fourth grade classrooms, five fifth grade classrooms, two self-contained rooms, three computer labs, two science and project labs, two art rooms, two music rooms, and a full-size cafeteria with a multipurpose room, along with administration and support office areas.

The building was designed to incorporate the latest technology available to the CCSD. Carolina Park features two separate play areas for pre-k through first grade, and second through fifth grades, both including synthetic turf surfacing.
