PROJECT UPDATE 1/11/2018

This project is complete. The 5,000 square foot Emergency Operations Center was constructed to house the Security Monitoring for CCSD and place the CCSD IT servers in a facility above the Base Flood Elevation. It also serves as two conference rooms for the CCSD staff at Bridgeview replacing the rooms at 206 A&B that will be turned into Administrative Offices. The building contains offices for 24/7 security monitoring for CCSD schools/facilities and provides a facility that will be the main Operations Center for CCSD during a natural disaster or emergency. The purpose is to serve as a central command and control facility responsible for carrying out the principles of emergency preparedness and emergency management, or disaster management functions at a strategic level during an emergency, and ensuring the continuity of operation of the Charleston County School District.
