PROJECT COMPLETE

North Charleston Creative Arts Elementary School was a phased project to replace the aging Bonds Wilson Campus. Located in the heart of North Charleston, the new school was designed to support an art infused partial magnet school offering visual and performing arts curriculum. The 84,000sf facility was designed to accommodate 600 students in grades Pre-K through Fifth. The state-of-the-art school houses typical classrooms, a Media Center, Cafeteria, Multipurpose Room, Computer Labs and Project Labs. The school has a designated arts wing containing rooms for art, drama, instrumental music, chorus and a dance studio. The design of the facility includes a centrally located art gallery that is used to exhibit student work and incorporates colorful and whimsical interiors to encourage creativity and inspire students.
