7:30 p.m. – Military Magnet Academy Eagles vs. R.B. Stall Warriors

8:10 p.m. – Bishop England Battling Bishops vs. James Island Trojans

8:50 p.m. - Baptist Hill Bobcats vs. Wando Warriors

Each exhibition contest will last 24 minutes (running clock). The game clock will stop when a team scores, for a change of possession, and significant injuries.

The district attempted to host this event last year, but the jamboree was canceled due to COVID-19.
