## **Schedule changes finalized for CCSD Football Jamboree**

**Charleston, SC** – The first-ever Charleston County School District (CCSD) Football Jamboree will now have three exhibition contests. The inaugural event is still scheduled for Friday, August 13, 2021, at Robert E. Hayes Field at the District 2 Regional Stadium, but will now start at 6:30 p.m.

The 2021 CCSD Football Jamboree matchups are as follows (start times following first contest are approximate):

**6:30 p.m. – Baptist Hill Bobcats vs. Academic Magnet Raptors**

**7:10 p.m. – R.B. Stall Warriors vs. North Charleston Cougars**

**7:50 p.m. – James Island Trojans vs. St. John's Islanders**

Four teams had to withdraw due to COVID-19 protocols: Burke High School, Military Magnet Academy, Wando High School, and West Ashley High School.

Each exhibition contest will last 24 minutes (running clock). The game clock will stop when a team scores, change of possession, and significant injuries.

### **TICKET SALES**

The district is only using [GoFan](#) for ticket sales (**worth \$5 each**). Purchasing tickets ahead of time is recommended, but fans can pay for tickets on their smartphones and mobile devices at the gate as well.
