Charleston County School District opens student registration May 10

Charleston, SC – Registration for all grades will open tomorrow, Tuesday, May 10 2022 at 5:00 p.m. All students – new and returning – must register and provide residency verification. Access to the registration system can be found [here](#).

Families of currently enrolled students and students that accepted seats through the Choice and transfer processes can register once they receive instructions via email from noreplyregistration@powerschool.com. New families can create an account in the enrollment system allowing them to save their progress as they complete the registration.

One exception, Head Start/Early HeadStart and Child Development families will receive qualification letters and registration information in the beginning of June and the beginning of August via email from noreplyregistration@powerschool.com.

All students must be registered by the first day of the 2022-2023 school year.

“Annual registration and residency verification is now required to ensure that school officials have up-to-date information on each student,” said Cathleen Milne, Director of Student Information. “The new registration software is easy to navigate and the prompts are easy to follow. The registration platform allows families to save their progress and return to complete the registration at their convenience.”
