Lucy Beckham hires Jamel Smith as head football coach

Mount Pleasant, SC - Jamel Smith has been named the Head Football Coach at Lucy Beckham High School opening in the fall of 2020.

Coach Smith comes to Beckham from Wando High School where he's been the defensive coordinator for the last four years.

While a student athlete at Spring Valley High School, he was All-State and was honored to play in the SC/NC Shrine Bowl. After graduation, he received a football scholarship to Virginia Tech. He played in the 2000 National Championship vs. Florida State University.

Smith's senior year he was Second Team All-American. After that, he played three years with NFL Europe for the Rhein Fire. While in the NFL Europe, he played in two World Bowl Championships. When Jamel stopped playing football, he started coaching at his alma mater. He left Spring Valley to become a G.A. at Virginia Tech (2008-09) and then an assistant coach at Coastal Carolina (2010-2011).

"Coach Smith is a fantastic addition to our team both in the classroom and on the football field," said Principal Anna Dassing. "His ability to connect with student athletes and grow them from boys to young men of character and integrity is second to none."
