2019 - 2020 JICHS Flex Pass Frequently Asked Questions

Who is eligible for a Flex Pass?

Juniors and Seniors who have met College-Career Readiness benchmarks are eligible for a Flex Pass. A few criteria include scoring 20 or higher on the ACT, scoring 1020 or higher on SAT, earning 6 or more hours in dual credit with grades of “C” or better, and passing IB / AP exams. See your counselor for the complete list and to see if you qualify.

Can I attend ILT if I have a Flex Pass?

Yes, all James Island Charter High School students may attend ILT.

Can I stay late to see a teacher if I have a Flex Pass?

Any student with a Flex Pass that needs to stay during a time they would otherwise be off-campus should have a signed pass from a teacher that includes the date, time, and your destination.

I qualify for a Flex Pass, but I do not have transportation. Can I still have a Flex Pass?

All students that are issued Flex Passes are expected to leave campus within 5 minutes of their scheduled classes concluding. We understand that many of you have unique needs related to transportation. Please speak with your administrator to come up with a solution. You may not loiter on campus in an unsupervised area.

Where am I allowed to wait on my ride?

All students being picked up or dropped off should enter and exit the school through the Front Atrium. Students that need to wait on their rides may do so in the front atrium. Students are not allowed to remain in the front atrium for the duration of their Flex Periods. All students will be required to show their 2019 - 2020 JICHS ID and proof of their Flex Pass to leave campus.

If I get to school early, where can I wait for the bell to ring?

Students arriving to school before 2nd period or 4th period should report to the cafeteria. Students arriving during ILT / before 3rd period may visit their teachers, attend club meetings, or enjoy their lunch in the cafeteria or courtyard.

What is considered satisfactory school attendance?

Students are expected to be at school each day and attend all of their scheduled classes. Students with unexcused or unlawful absences have unsatisfactory attendance. Students that miss more than the allowable number of days for any class have unsatisfactory attendance. These issues, as well as skipping class, will put your Flex Pass in jeopardy.

What will happen if my Flex Pass is revoked?

If your Flex Pass is revoked, you will be assigned study hall during your Flex Period for the duration of the term. Flex Periods during subsequent terms may be replaced with courses. Your administrator and school counselor will determine what's best for you.
