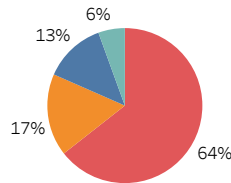

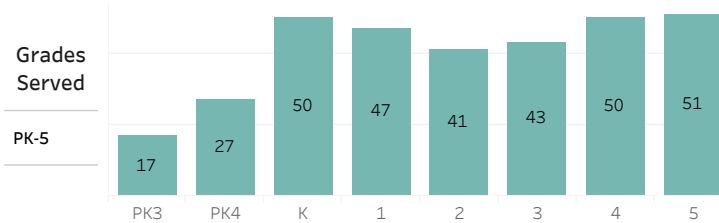

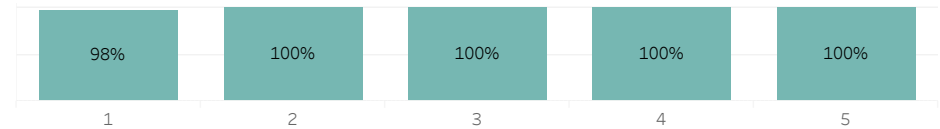

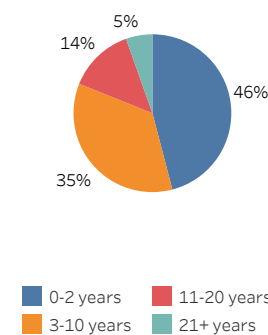

To compute it, for each student, the number of days they were in attendance in 2020-21 was divided by the number of days they were enrolled in a CCSD school in 2020-21. Excused and unexcused absences were not counted as being in attendance. The percentage of days present was averaged across all students who were actively enrolled in the school on day 135 of 2020-21.

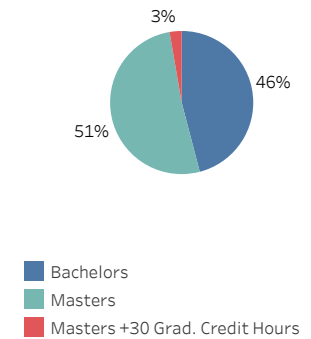

### 2020-21 Teacher Degree



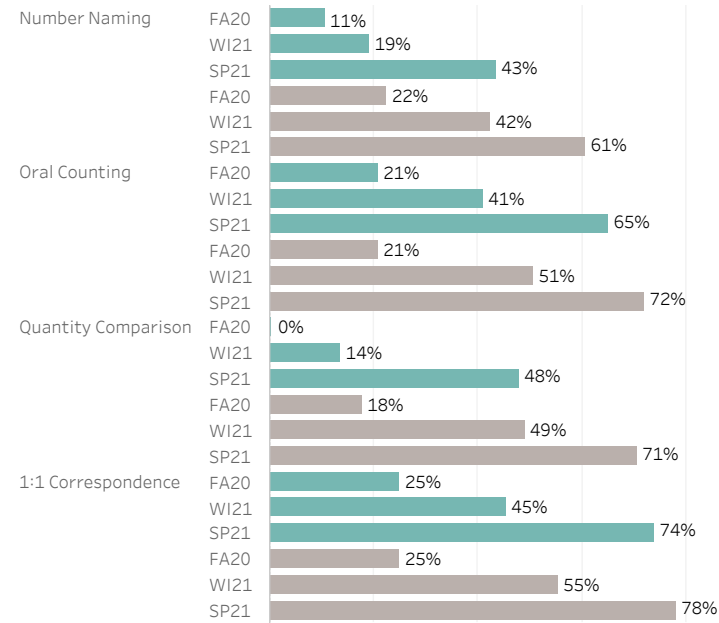
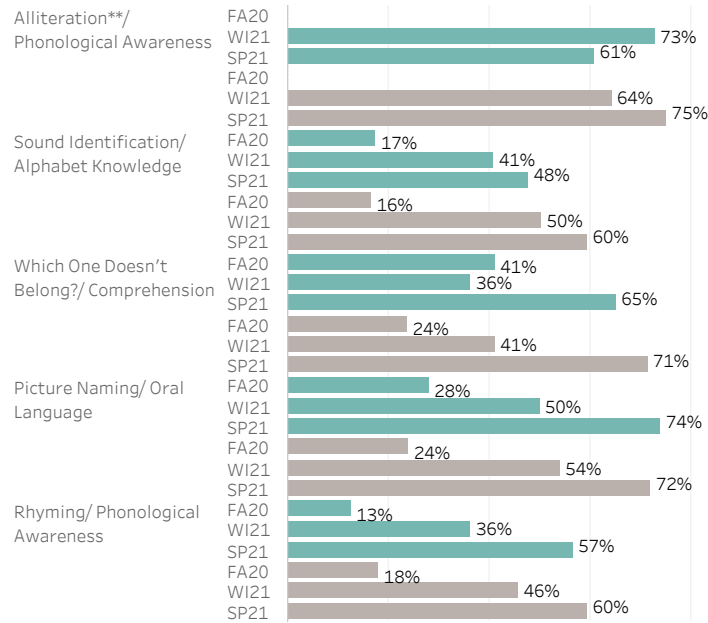

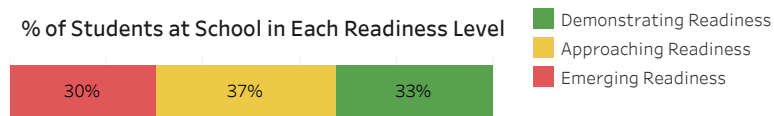
Fall 2020 Kindergarten Readiness Assessment (KRA) Results

### Average Sub-Test and Overall Scores

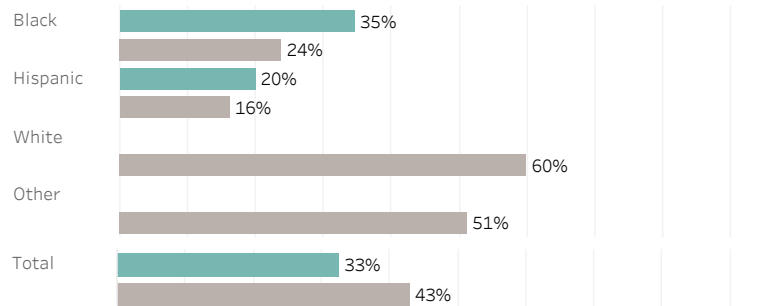

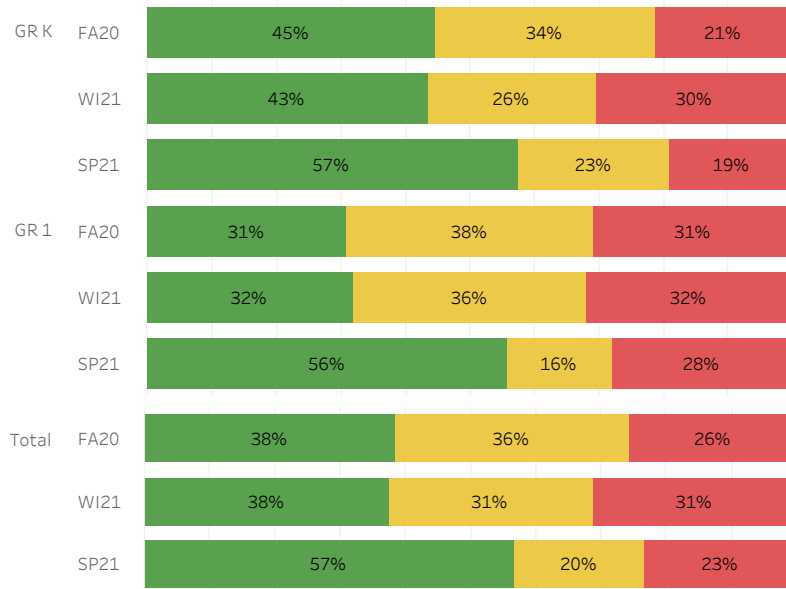
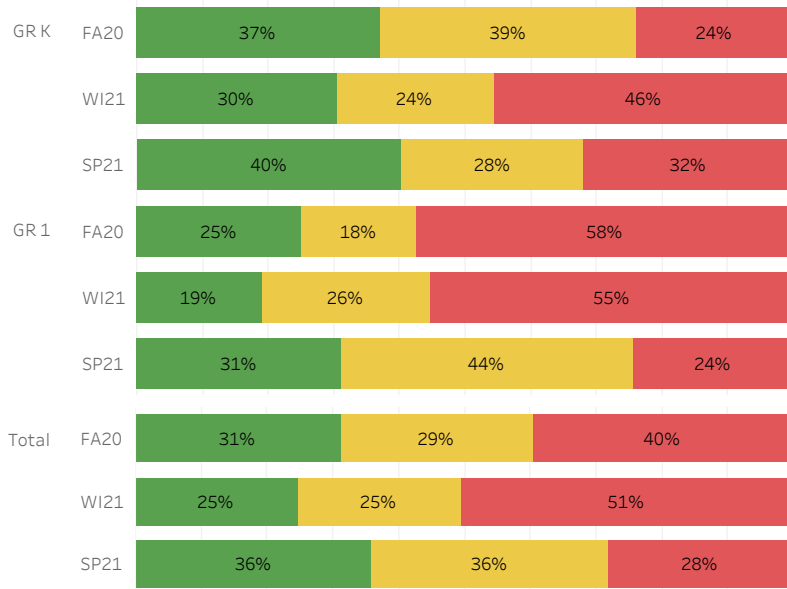

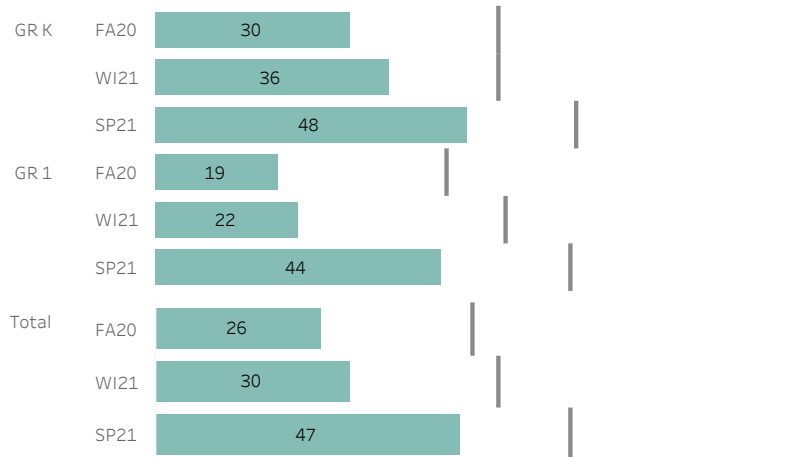

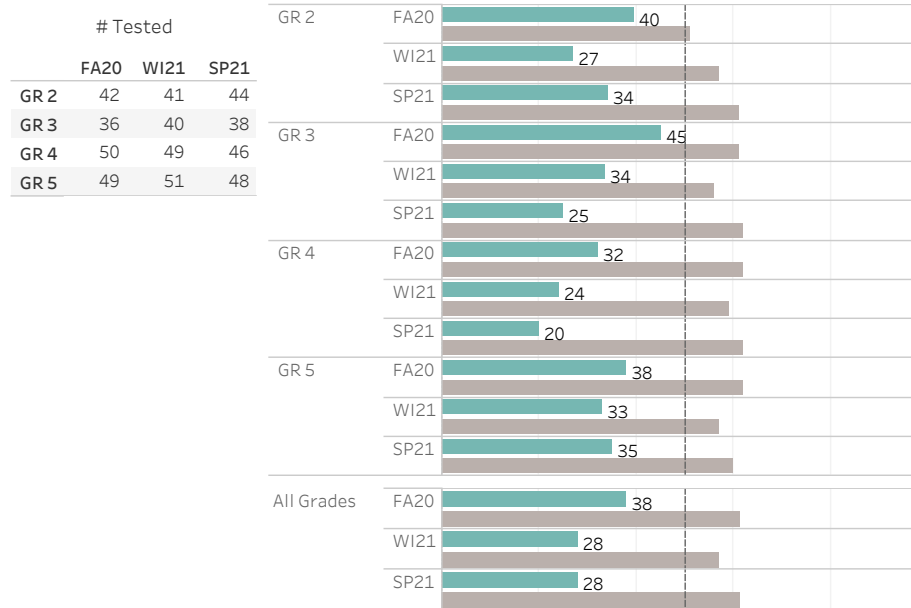

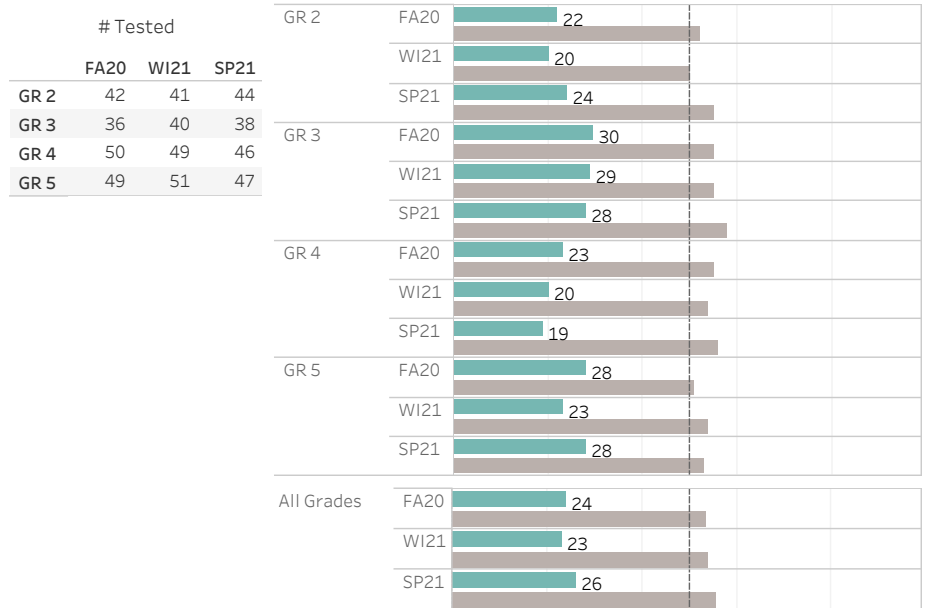

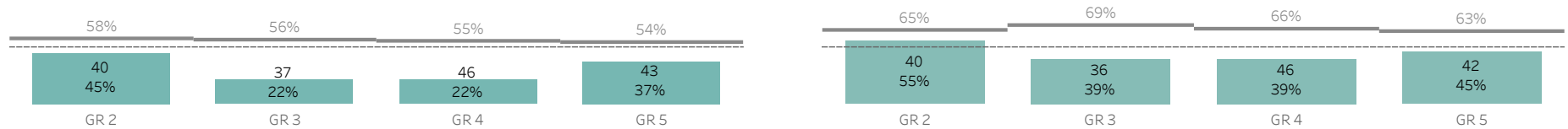

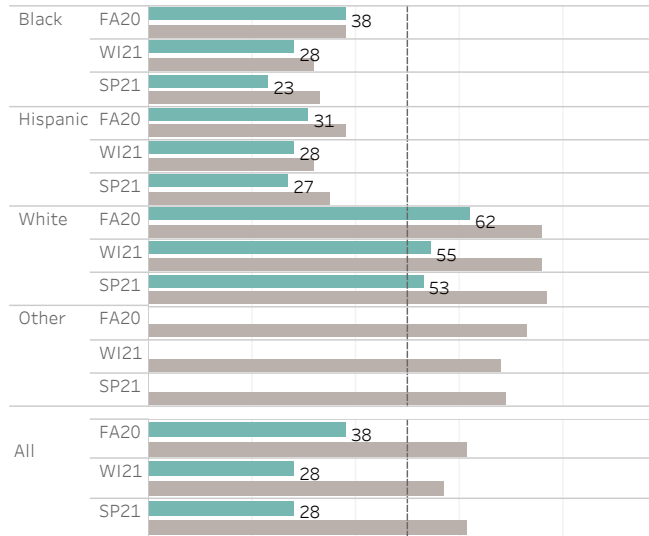

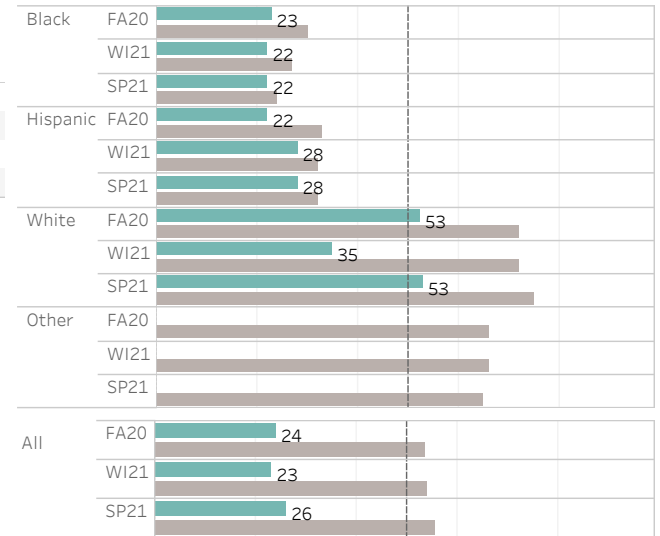

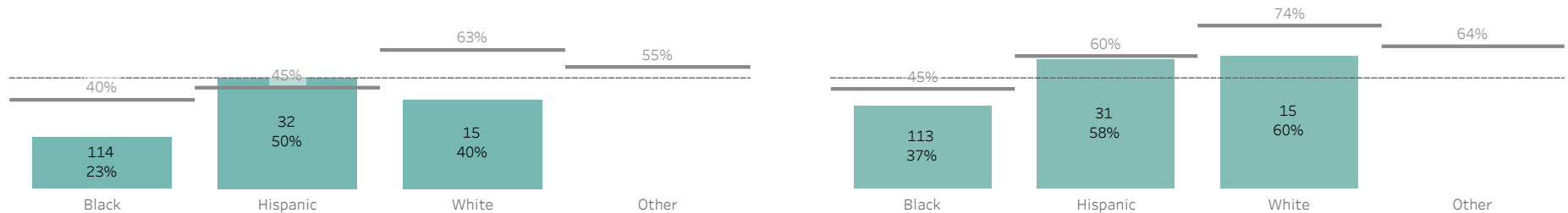
