





2019-20 Teacher Experience 2019-20 Teacher Degree







Fall 2019 & Winter 2020 myIGDIs (my Individual Growth & Development Indicators): % of PreKindergarten Students in Tier I













Fall 2019, Winter 2020, Fall 2020, & Winter 2021 FastBridge: % of Students in Each Risk Category










Fall 2020 & Winter 2021 Median Percentile
