Our Mission

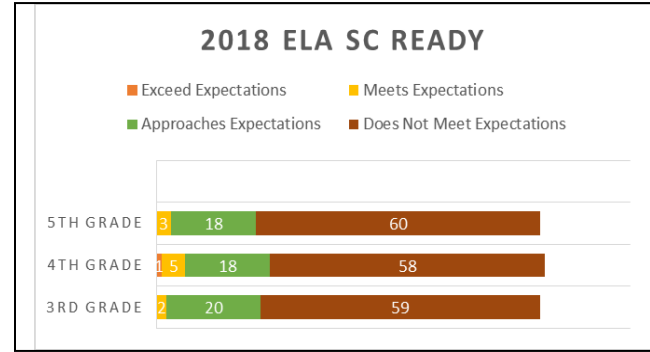

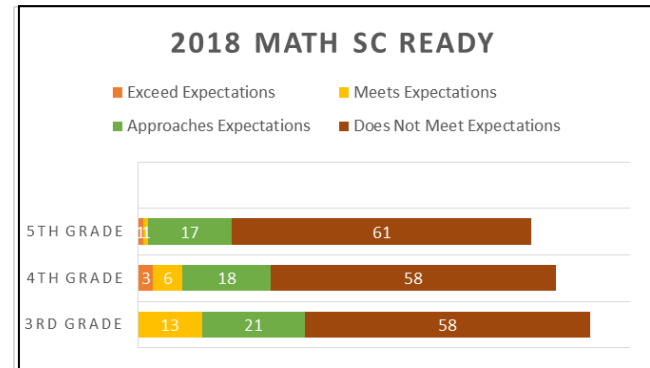
Core Strategies for School Renewal

6. Organize staffing and provide effective training to successfully support high performance.

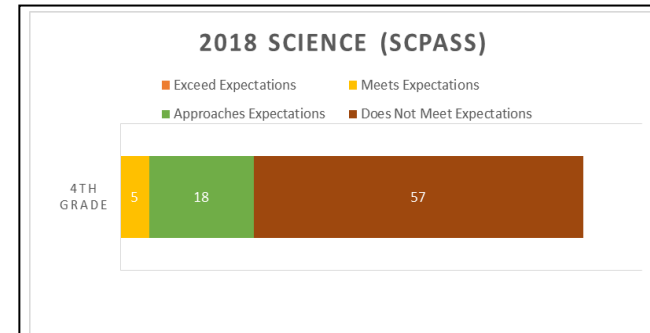
2018 ELA SC READY
