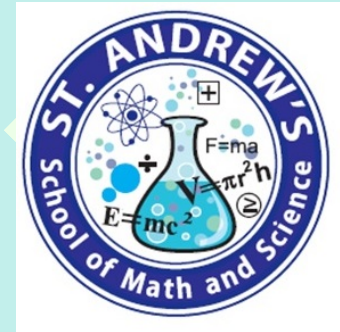

- **Curriculum Input**- The SIC team participates in informational presentations and status updates on new curriculum that are used in various grade levels.



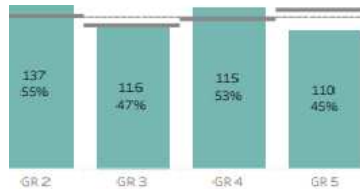
PTA Projects

- **Field Trip Support**:- Provides funds to pay for field trip costs for students who have a financial need.

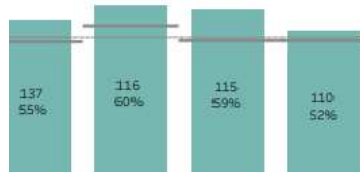
