

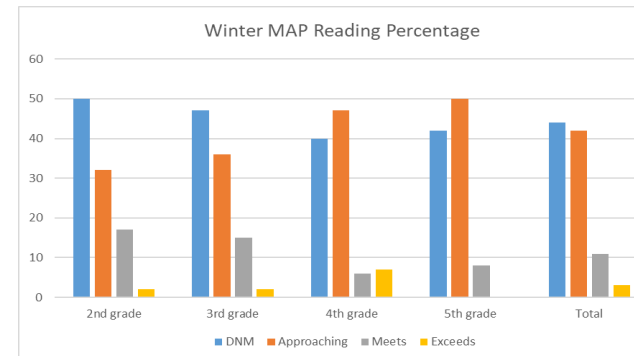
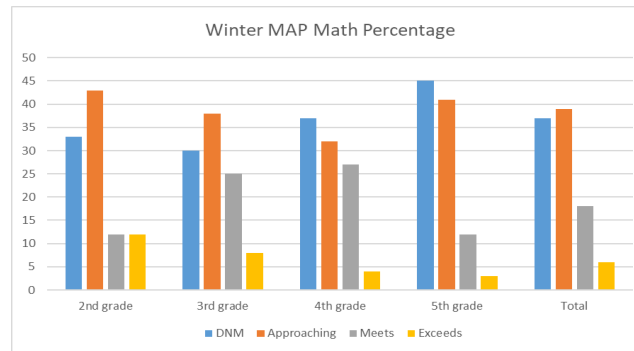
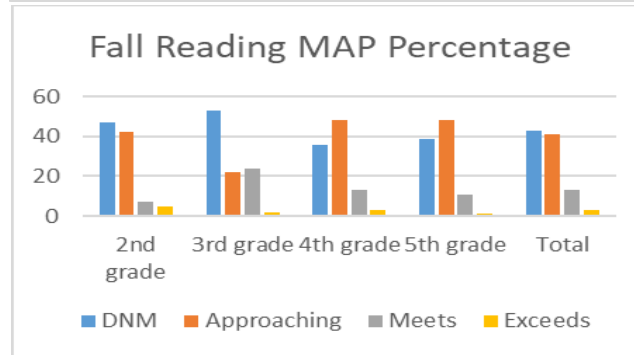
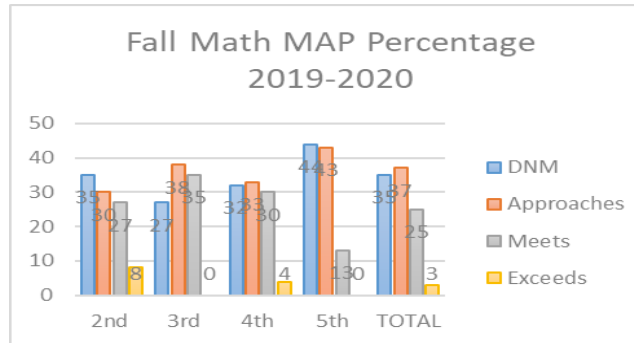
School-wide Goals
