Where available, results shown represent students who completed the Pre-ACT (top) or the ACT (bottom) in 2020-21. The Pre-ACT is typically taken by students in their second year of high school. ACT results only shown for students in their third and fourth year of high school in 2020-21 who completed the ACT in 2020-21. The Pre-ACT uses a 35 -point scale and the ACT uses a 36-point scale. The Composite score is an average of the score students receive on the four sub-tests (English, Reading, Math, and Science). STEM represents a combination of math and science scores. ACT established the benchmark scores as the minimum score needed on an ACT subject-area test to indicate a $50 \%$ chance of obtaining a B or higher or about a 75\% chance of Obtaining a C or higher in the corresponding credit-bearing college course (English predicts English Composition, Reading predicts Social Sciences, Math predicts College Algebra, and Science predicts Biology). These benchmark values are: English $=18$, Math $=22$, Reading $=22$, and Science $=23$. A composite score of 20 indicates college readiness as defined by the state, 24 is a qualifying score for LIFE Scholarship eligibility and 27 is a qualifying score for Palmetto Fellows Scholarship eligibility. Results only shown when data represent at least 10 students or more to ensure no individual student is identified.
