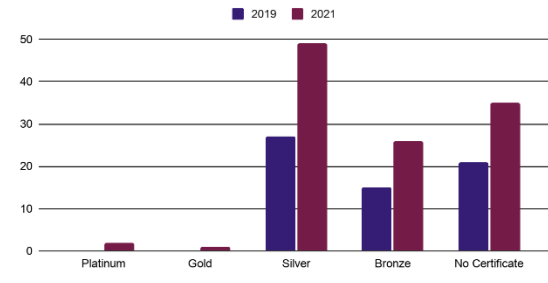

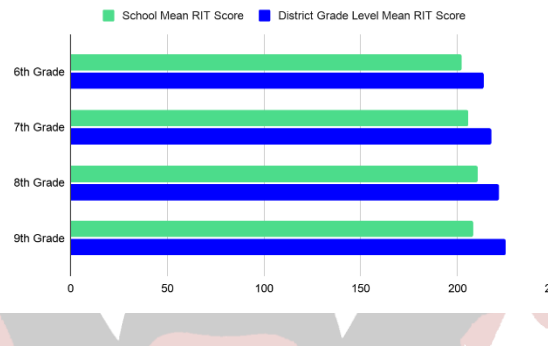

Number of Students Who Earned WIN Credentials

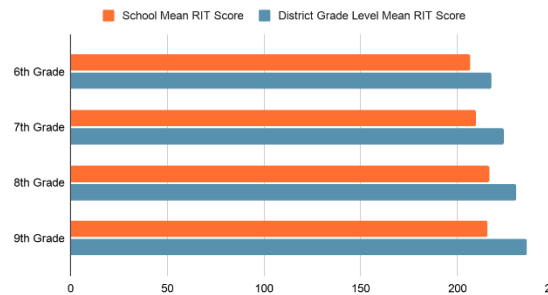
