Vision Statement: Baptist Hill Middle High School is a comprehensive, high performing, community school that nurtures students, supports educators, and serves the community.

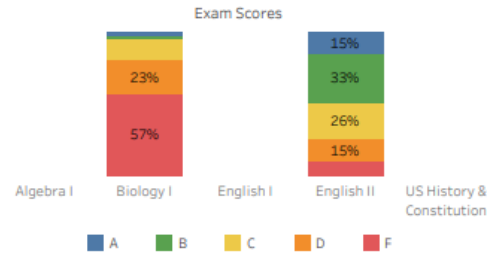

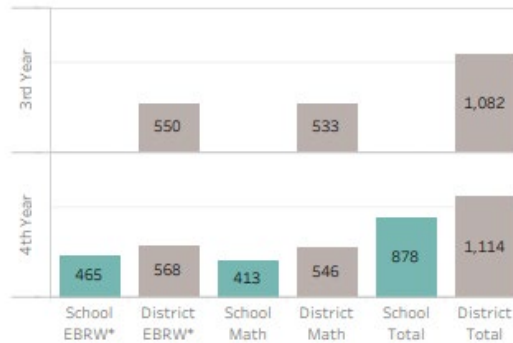

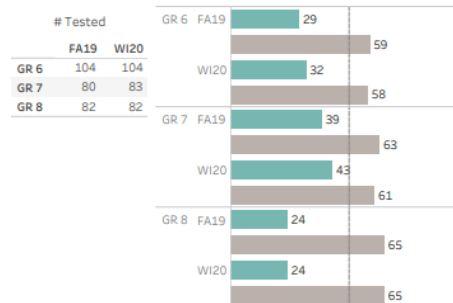
Fall 2019 End of Course Examination
