TECHNOLOGY ACCEPTABLE USE

Code IJNDB Issued 9/05

Purpose: To establish the board's vision and the basic structure for the acceptable use of technology resources in Charleston County School District.

The superintendent shall permit no use of technology that is unlawful or unethical, which is for purposes other than educational or district business, and which fails to conform to district technology and security standards.

The superintendent or his/her designee shall appoint a committee composed of community, business and district representatives to provide ongoing technology standards for use in schools and offices of Charleston County School District.

Instructional and student use of technology shall comply with Charleston County School District policy DJBC.
