2. Information/Action Item**Action, Information:** A. Update regarding online and in-person enrollment

Motion to approve expanded services for both online and in-person learning in order to respond to parent preferences, with September 21 as the implementation date.

> For schools where a majority of students are learning online, engage CCSD personnel to work with non-profit organizations, faith-based groups, community volunteers and families to arrange instructional support groups located in communities where families live;

> For in-person requests, admit for in-person instruction 5 days per week all students with August 28 confirmed seating preferences. K-8 students are to return by Sept. 21. High school students will return as soon as possible, but by at least the first week in October. If there are remaining students on the waitlist, they will be worked in as quickly as safe seating is available.

In all instances the district will adhere to Safe Restart guidelines, safe seating capacities, and operate within state or district policies when making the necessary adjustments to teacher caseloads and assignments. Teachers uncomfortable with returning to and/or providing in-person learning by September 21 may work with Human Resources to apply for either FFCRA or FMLA, if eligible/as applicable.
