TUITION INCOME

Code DFG Issued 5/17

Purpose: To establish the basic structure for collection of tuition from nonresident students.

The board shall collect tuition from nonresident students enrolled in Charleston County School District schools which the board may set or reconfirm annually (see JFAB - Admission of Nonresident Students).

The district shall collect one half of the annual tuition by August 1September 30th of the school year. The district shall collect the second half of the tuition by December 1January 31st of the school year. The procedure for collection of tuition will be set forth in an administrative regulation. Such funds shall be deposited in the general fund account.

The superintendent shall make an annual report to the board on the number of non-resident students paying tuition, the home districts represented, and the total revenue collected.
