3. Multiple siblings applying and living in Constituent District 20 (If one is accepted, the next sibling is given priority.)
4. Student of CCSD employee living in Constituent District 20
5. Student living in Constituent District 20
6. Student of CCSD employee living out of Constituent District 20 and in Charleston County
7. Student living out of Constituent District 20 and in Charleston County
8. Student of CCSD employee living out of Charleston County but eligible to attend CCSD magnet/choice schools
9. Student living out of Charleston County but eligible to attend CCSD magnet/choice schools
