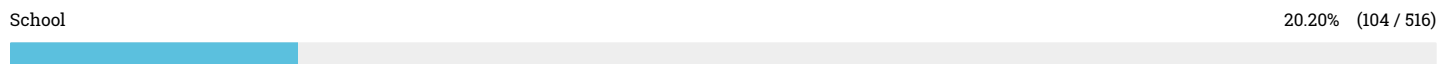

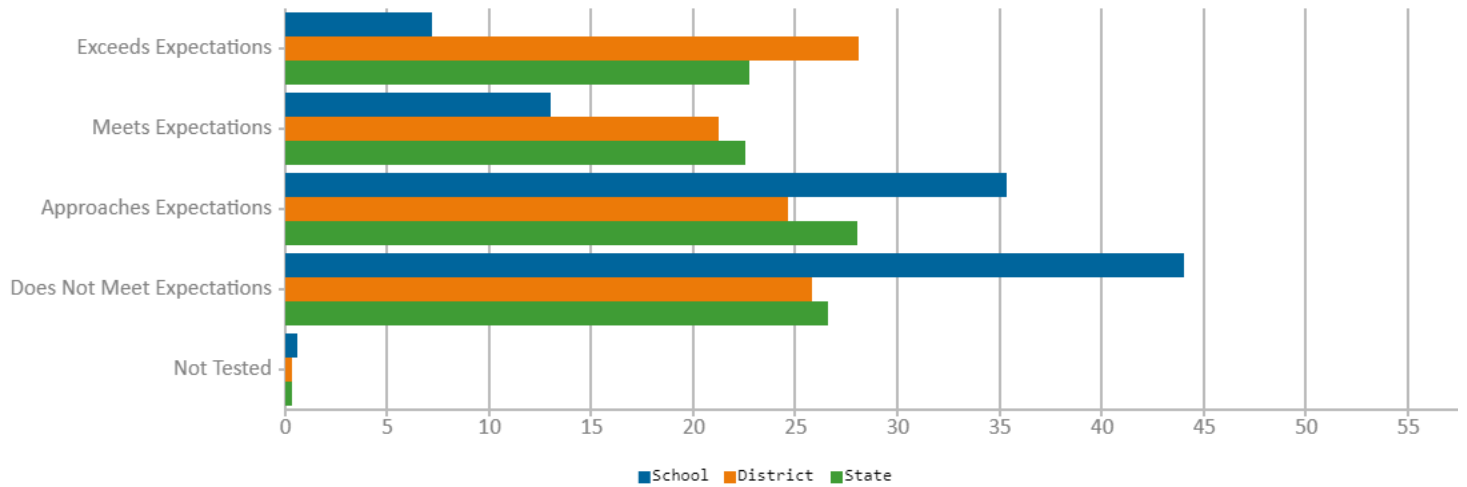

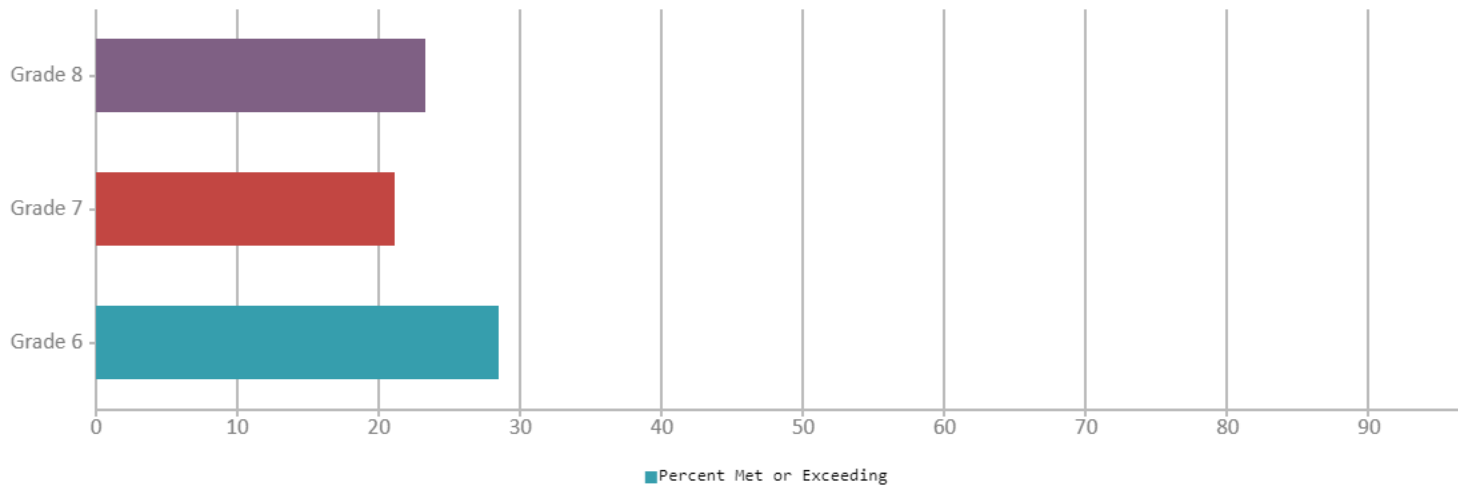

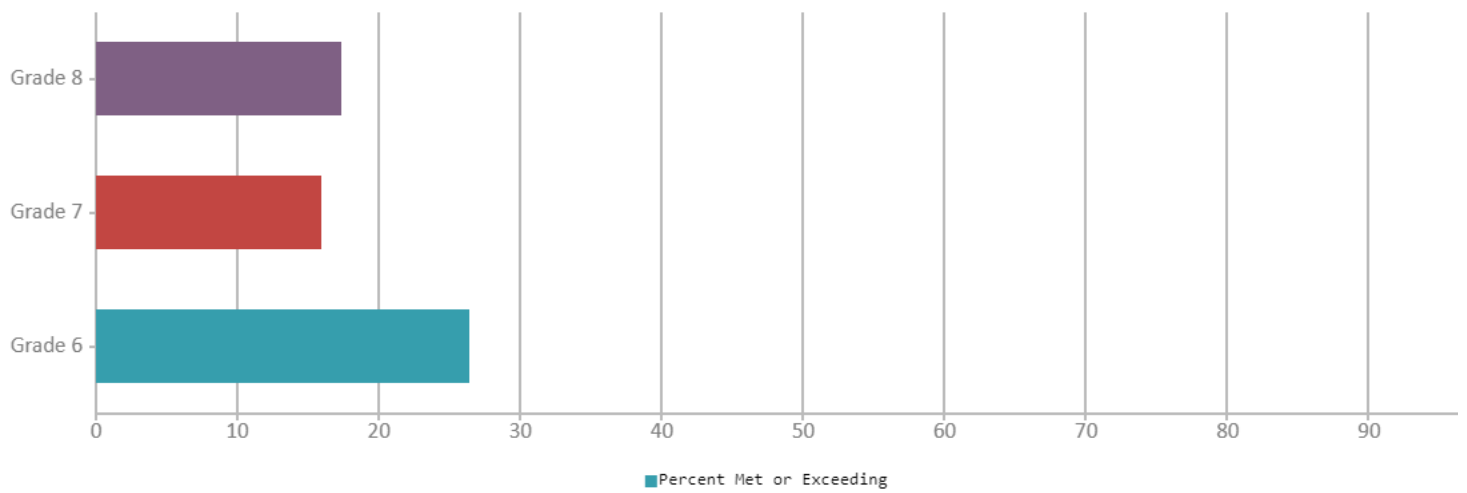

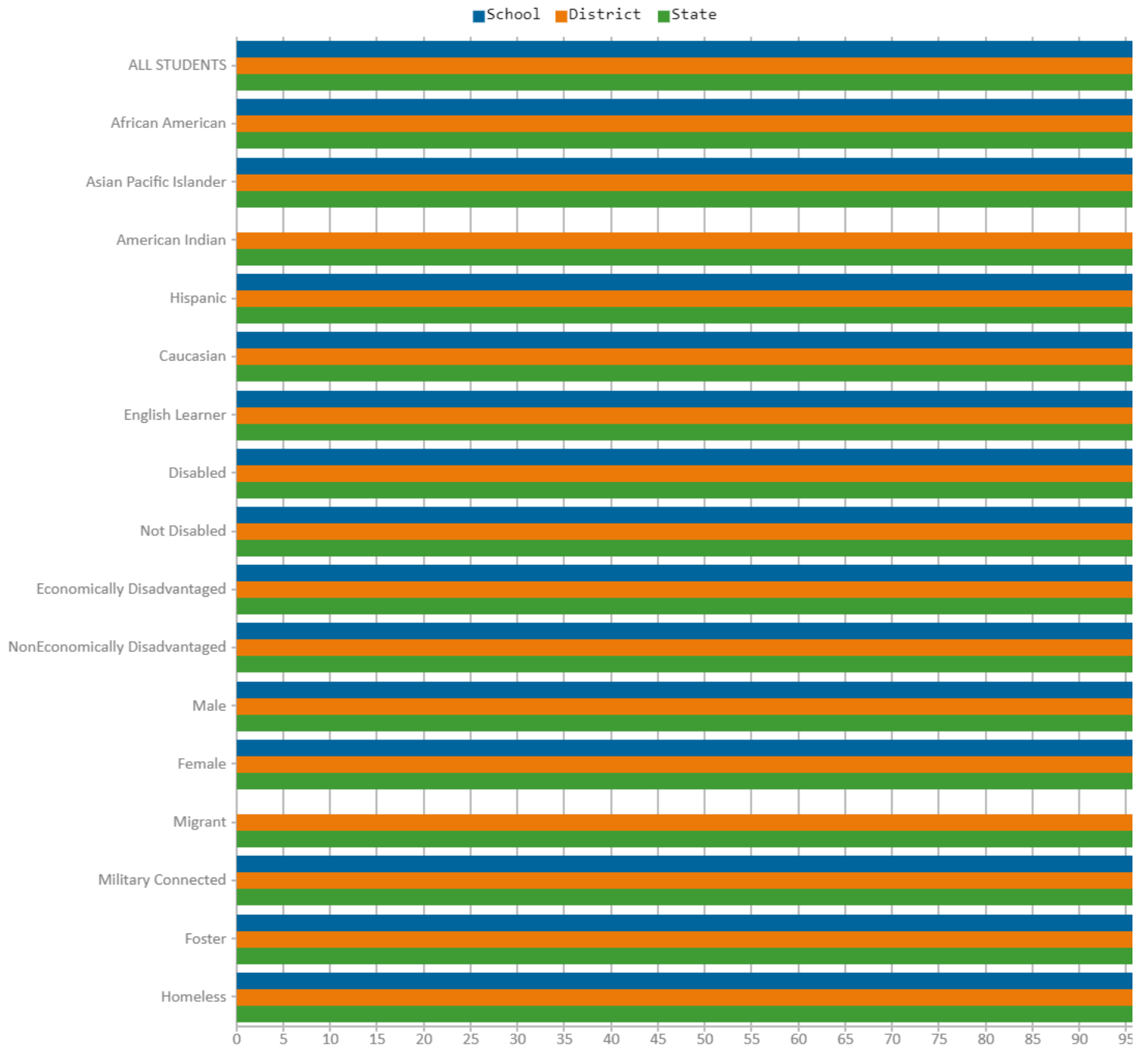

Participation Rate by Subgroup

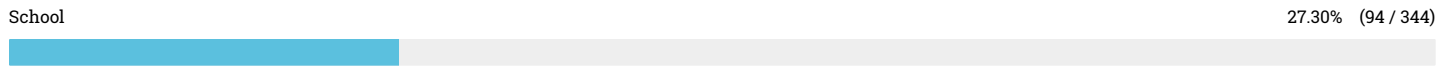

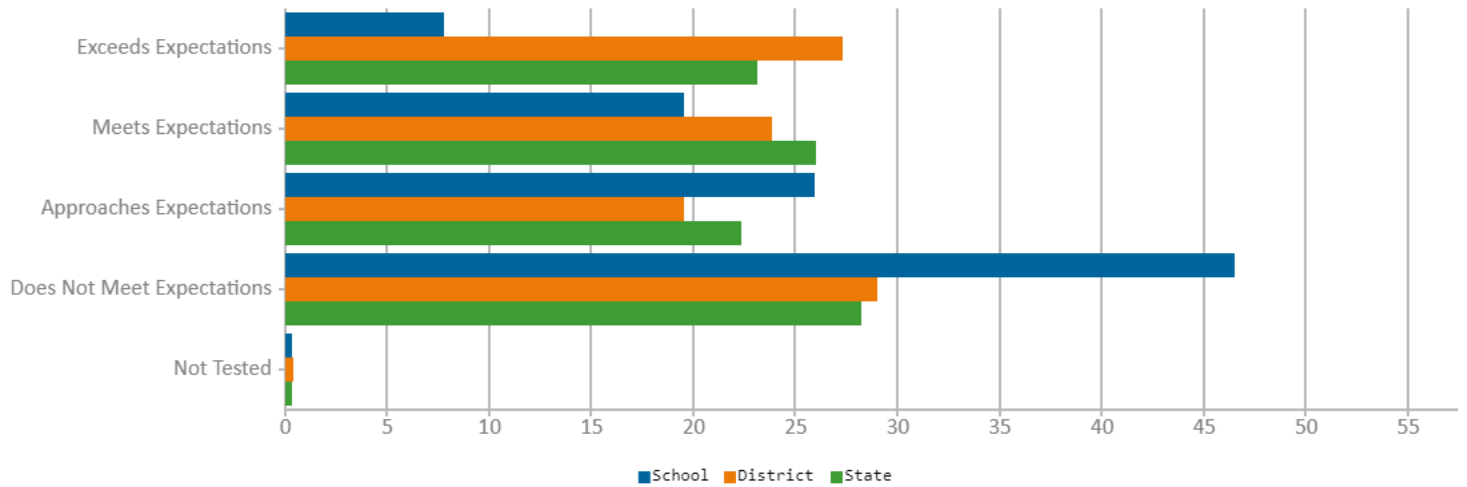

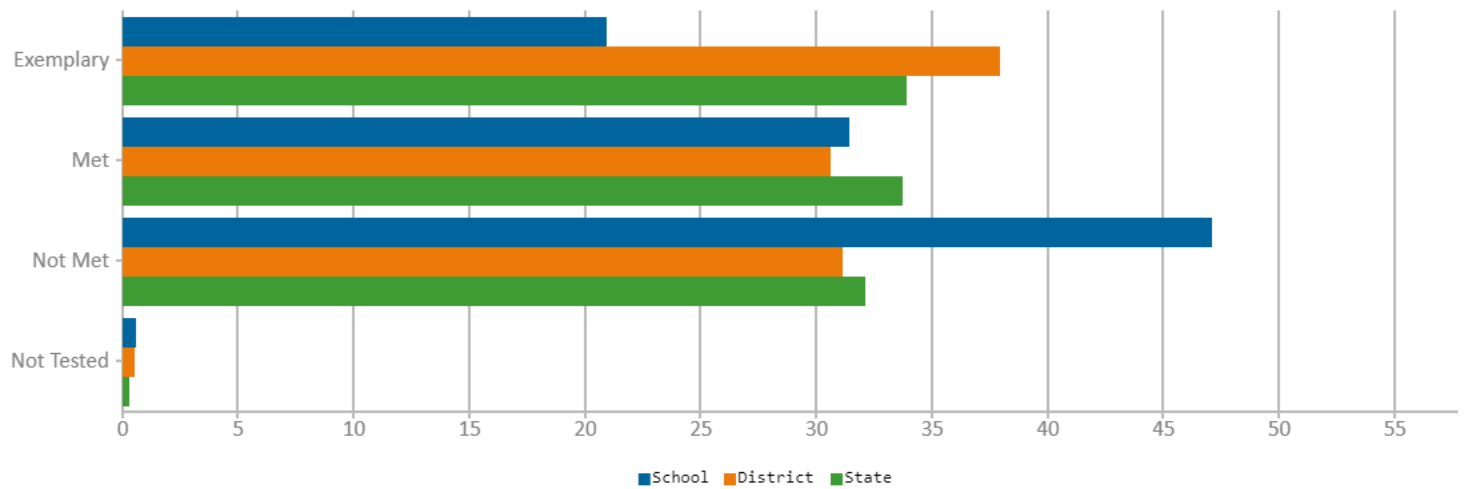

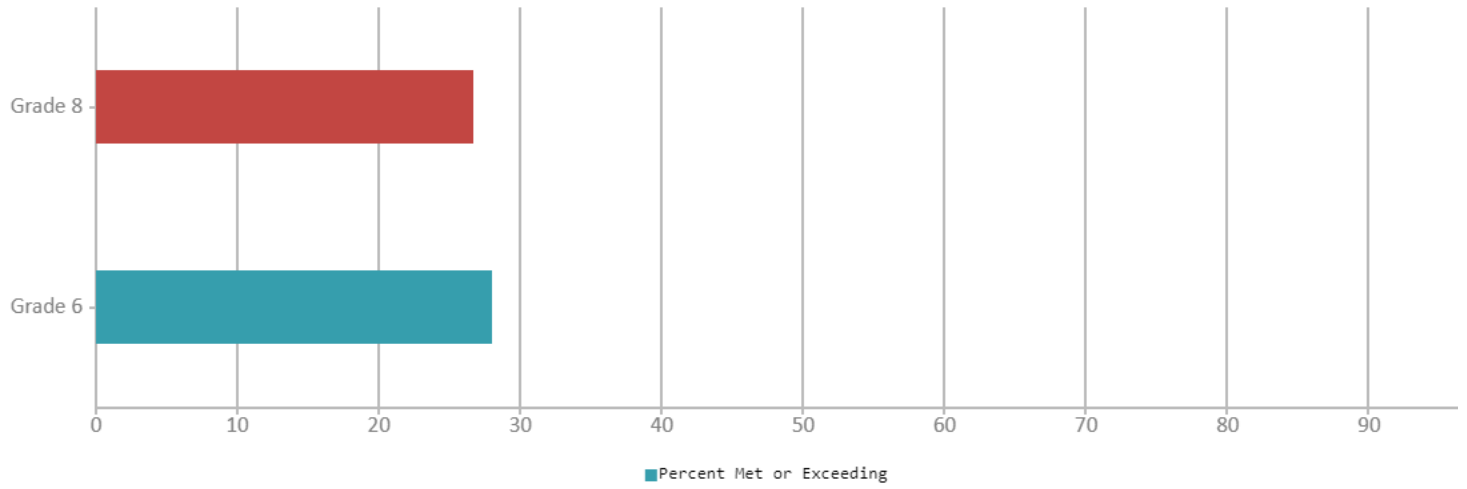

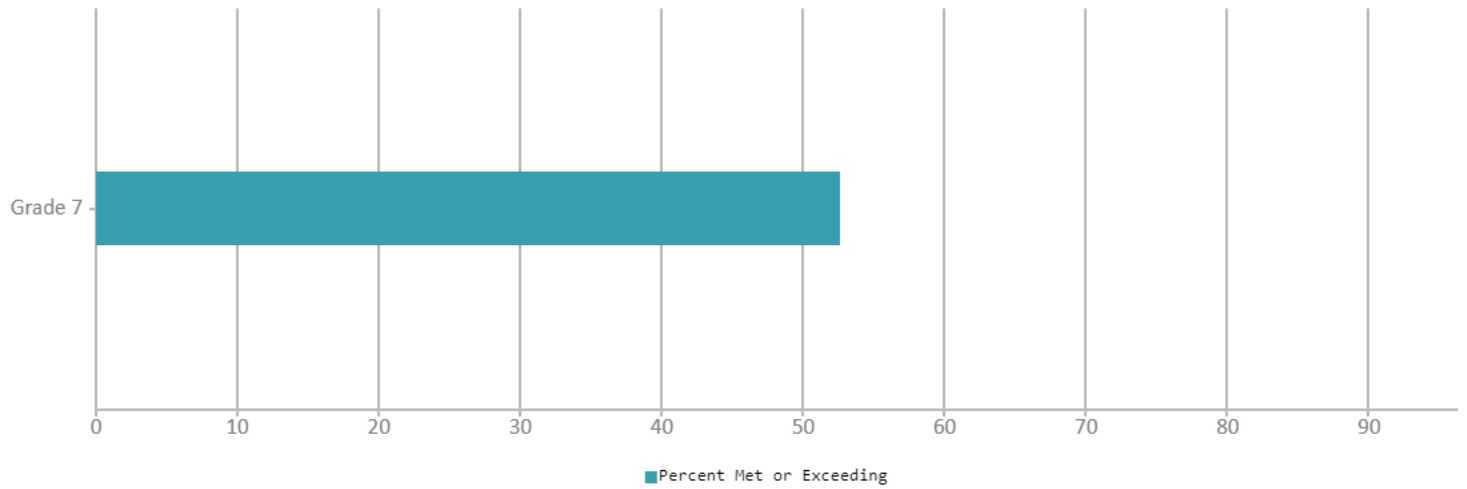

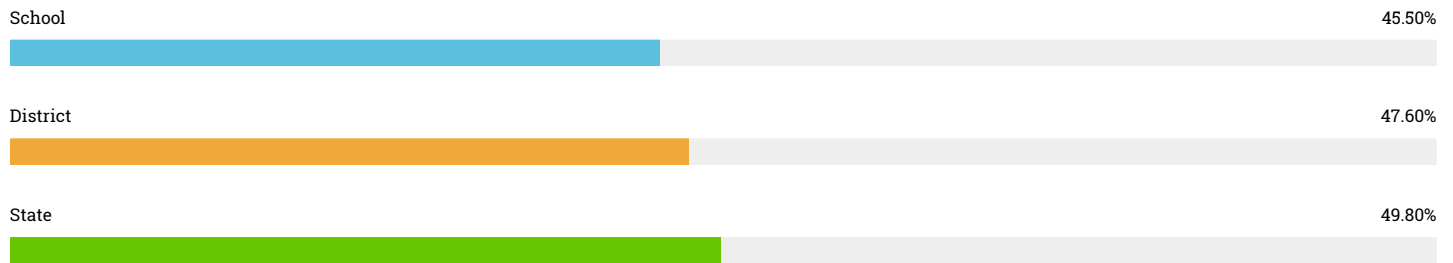
