



2023 Board Election Process

Allegro Charter School of Music is working with the Public Charter School Alliance of South Carolina (PCSASC) to hold this year's election process. This ensures integrity and confidentiality in the process.

The governing board consists of seven (7) members. Three (3) elected seats, each for a term of two years, are currently up for election.

February 9, 2023: Candidate Filing Opens - Each prospective board member must complete an application online. PCSASC will have these available online for submission/distribution. Links will be created from Allegro Charter School of Music's site.

February 17, 2023: Filing period ends. Acceptance of candidate filings will be closed at **12:00 pm (Noon)**.

February 20, 2023: Candidate profiles will be posted online.

February 22-24, 2023: Voting open with e-ballot links emailed to eligible voters of Allegro Charter School of Music. Voting will open on **February 22, 2023, at 8:00 am** and close on **February 24, 2023, at 5:00 pm**. There is one vote per child enrolled in the school and one vote per employee. Voting will be available via e-ballot allowing parents and employees to vote via the internet. Each ballot will have a unique pin number to ensure confidentiality and integrity of the process. Computers will be available at the school during normal school hours for those who may need additional assistance in voting.

February 27, 2023: Election results will be certified and announced publicly. School board members will be announced publicly.

March 13, 2023: Newly elected board members will be sworn in at the board meeting. This will complete the election process.

Meeting and Training Requirements:

Allegro Charter School of Music Board Members are required to attend all board meetings.

Mandated Board Training – All board members are required by state law to attend board training within 1 year of taking office.
