I. Application Priorities:

CCSD Choice schools fall into the following categories: Countywide Magnet, Countywide Admissions Criteria Magnet, Constituent District Magnet, Montessori/ Partial Magnet, and Charter schools.

County Wide: These schools have a specific focus, use the application and lottery process for admission, and do not have an attendance zone.

- These schools have specific admissions criteria
- They are available through the application/admissions process to residents of Charleston County. Admissions Criteria are unique for each of the schools.
- Multiples criteria does not apply for this category of schools (except for CPA).

Constituent District Magnet: This school has a specific focus and serves students within the designated Constituent attendance zone in which the school is located.

- Only students with home address in District 2 can attend Sullivan's Island Elementary School or James B. Edwards Elem
- Only students with home address in District 4 can attend Zucker Middle School or North Charleston Creative Arts Elem
- Only students with home address in District 9 or District 3 can attend Haut Gap Middle School
- Only students with home address in District 10 can attend Ashley River C. A. Elem School and St. Andrew's Math & Science
- Only students with home address in District 10 and District 23 can attend Montessori Community School
- Only students with home address in District 23 can attend E.B. Ellington Elementary School
- Only students with home address in District 20 can attend Mitchell Elementary School
- Zone Transportation is provided
- Multiples or Sibling currently attending priorities apply
- CCSD Employee priority applies only when residence is in designated constituent zone

Montessori/Partial Magnet: These schools have a specific focus and determined attendance zones. Additional seats may be allocated to students living outside of the attendance zone.

- School living in enrollment zone
- Siblings of currently enrolled student living in Charleston County
- Multiple siblings applying and living in Charleston County(if one is accepted, sibling is given priority)
- Student of CCSD Employee living in Charleston County
- Student living in constituent district
- Student of CCSD employee living out of Constituent district and in Charleston County
- Student living out of Constituent district and in Charleston County.
- Student of CCSD employee residing outside of Charleston County but eligible to attend CCSD magnet/choice schools
- Students residing outside Charleston county but eligible to attend CCSD magnet by owning real property in Charleston County in the name of the student with a tax assessed value of \$300.00 or more and paying tuition

II. Children of CCSD Employees:

- An employee is determined as someone who works at least 30 hours per week on average and works a minimum of 180 days.
- The district may admit the children of nonresident custodial employees provided the following criteria are met:
 - The parent/legal guardian submits a release form from the school district in which he/she resides.
 - The parent/legal guardian makes an application according to the approved timeline, process and format as posted on the link below or as found at the Charleston County School District's website.
 - There is available space as determined by the district's calendar of capacity and enrollment projections.
 - The parent/guardian must provide annual proof of current CCSD employment.
 - Nonresident tuition charges will be waived for children of employees for as long as the custodial parent of the student remains employed by the district and meets the definition of "employee" as specified in Policy JFABCA Voluntary Transfers For Children Of CCSD Employees.

III. Special Needs

CCSD has highly specialized instructional programs for students with significant needs in strategic locations throughout the district and provides reasonable accommodations for all students to access instruction and the educational environment. If your child has been identified as a student who has an IEP or 504 Plan, his / her IEP Team or 504 Team must meet prior to enrollment to consider the educational needs of the student, determine the program required to ensure a Free and Appropriate Public Education, and determine if the chosen school placement is able to meet the requirements of the IEP within the existing programs within the school (see 34 CFR 300.116 and 34 CRF 300.114 through 300.120 of the IDEA Regulations).

IV. Transportation

Transportation to a CCSD magnet/choice school is provided from centralized bus stops. This is not the same pick up process as for students attending their "home" attendance zone school.

CCSD does not transport students younger than 4yrs old.

Centralized locations are used for magnet/choice school bus stops and could be as far as five miles from your home in commercial or unsupervised areas within the designated constituent district. (See chart on next page)

These are parent assisted bus stops and are not intended to be stops to which most students can walk or be left unattended.

IEP teams may determine transportation needs for students who may require additional provisions. For most efficient routing, riders may be pooled with a wide range of age groups on the same bus. This should be considered when submitting an application for a magnet school.

The detailed information regarding specific routes will be available near the beginning of school when routes are developed. Also please note, charter schools handle their own transportation and you should contact them directly if you are applying for a charter school and have questions related to transportation.

V. Out of County Residents/Students

Please be advised, pursuant to CCSD Policy JFAB - Nonresident Students, JFAB - R (its Administrative Rule), Policy DFG - Tuition Income, and State law, any student residing outside of Charleston County is required to own property in their name, with a tax assessed value of \$300.00 or more, within Charleston County, in order to retain a seat they may be offered. Out of county students, except for those specifically exempted, will be required to pay tuition to attend a CCSD school. Proof of property ownership by an out of county student is due no later than June 30, 2020, to the Office of General Counsel.

If a parent fails to provide verifiable proof that the student owns property within Charleston County by June 30, 2020, the student will lose the seat they may have been offered as of July 1, 2020, the day after the deadline. There will be no recourse for reconsideration. The seat offered to an out of county student who fails to provide proof of property ownership will be offered to another student on the waiting list.

VI. Policies:

VII. Entrance Age Requirements:

- **Preschool age children with disabilities:** The superintendent shall provide for all three, four and five year old children with disabilities who reside in the district a free appropriate public education, consistent with the federal Individuals with Disabilities Education Act.
- **Four year old child development:** Four year olds may apply for optional child development programs depending on space availability and following state regulations for such programs. Students must be four on or before September 1.
- **Kindergarten**
Students may enroll in kindergarten if they are either one of the following.
 - age five on or before September 1 of the school year
 - substantially began attending a public school kindergarten program in another state which has a different attendance age requirement from South Carolina
- **First grade**
Students may enroll in the first grade under one of the following conditions.
 - age six on or before September 1 of the school year
 - substantially began a first program in another state that has a different attendance requirement from South Carolina have attended a public school kindergarten program for one full school year
