

THE FOLLOWING IS AN UPDATE TO ALLEGRO'S DRESS CODE POLICY. IT IS INTENDED TO REPLACE PAGE 8 OF THE 2022-2023 STUDENT HANDBOOK for publication in 2023-2024 handbook.

The school administration has the discretion to determine appropriate or inappropriate attire. Students who are found to be in violation of the dress code are subject to disciplinary action.

Students who are not dressed in accordance with the dress code will be given a chance to call home for a change of clothes for the first violation. If the school has spare clothes, students will be allowed to wear those. Repeated dress code violations will result in the student being sent home and will enter the disciplinary process.

Permitted	NOT Permitted
Any Allegro logo shirt given to the student by the school or purchased from the school or PTO. The shirt can be short or long-sleeved. (not sleeveless) Any solid-colored collared shirts (short or long-sleeved; not sleeveless)	Tank tops, spaghetti strap, strapless tops, crop tops, and muscle shirts are prohibited. Translucent or mesh is not allowed. Undergarments shall not be exposed at any time. Clothing shall not reveal bare skin between upper chest and mid-thigh.
Solid-colored pants and skirts/shorts worn at waist level that have no holes and are a maximum of 3" above the knee.	No sweatpants, leggings, pajamas, or jeggings are permitted. No items with tears or holes.
Outerwear (jackets/coats) must be an Allegro sweatshirt/jacket OR a solid colored item with a zipper (to allow for display of the Allegro logo or solid-colored collared shirt underneath).	Allegro branded hoodies may be worn, but the hood may not be worn in the building.
A maximum headband of three inches in width to control hair is allowed. Items approved by administration for religious, health or other reasons are allowed.	No hats, bonnets, hoods, or large headpieces are allowed.
Closed-toed shoes with heel straps shall be worn at all times. Athletic shoes and boots are allowed.	Unsafe footwear is not allowed. [Rubber shoes (including cros), flip flops, heelys, slippers, backless sandals, slides, and high heels are not permitted.]

Student attire includes: clothing, hats, shoes, jewelry, emblem, page, symbol, sign, comment, or other items worn or displayed by an individual.

Physical Education Attire

- Must wear socks and tennis/running shoes. Students without appropriate footwear may not be allowed to participate.
- If the student changes out of the school uniform to participate in PE activities, the student must wear a solid-colored t-shirt and solid colored pants or shorts that meet the school dress code length (described above). Spandex and tank tops are not permitted.
- Students who change clothes to participate in PE activities must change back into the school uniform between classes (unless PE is the last class scheduled for the day).
