* Students may wear rainboots to and from school if they have sneakers they can change into.

As part of our behavior management system, students from time to time may be permitted to wear jeans or dress down. Parents will be notified in writing if this is the case. The school will not be responsible for lost or damaged clothing or accessories. We reserve the right to change or modify the dress code and will notify families should any changes arise.

Beginning in September, violating the dress code will be a minor behavior violation. If parents fix the uniform violation by 10am, it will not count as a minor behavior violation.

Because of the rigorous nature of our sports teams' practices, 5th & 6th grade athletes are allowed to dress in non-uniform clothes during practice and dinner. Items NOT Allowed: jeans of any type, shirts with offensive wording or inappropriate images, no midriff shirts. Athletes MUST wear: sneakers or cleats, socks, shirts.

During outdoor PE, 3rd-6th grade students may wear a white t-shirt in lieu of their uniform shirt during warm months.
