Week 2 March 11	Rock Climbing 	Experience the tallest man-made outdoor rock-climbing structure in the area at the 50-foot James Island Climbing Wall. Participants will be introduced to equipment and basic technique.	Climbing Wall at JICP
Week 3 March 18	High Challenge Course 	Participants will take their team building and trust to the next level on our high ropes Odyssey Course. The group will climb into the air, solve problems as a group.	Challenge Course at JICP
Week 4 March 25	Longboarding 	It's time to skate! Participants will have the opportunity learn about the parts and how to use a longboard before testing their skills throughout our paved paths here at James Island County Park!	Bike Barns at JICP
Week 5 April 1	SUP 	It's time for some Stand Up Paddle boarding! Club members will learn how to utilize equipment before gaining an understanding of basic paddle strokes on the lake at James Island County Park.	Lake at JICP
