



Service Distinction Leadership Project Proposal

1. Create a service project that you would like to lead. (You may work with one other student if you are doing a significant project that requires more than one person)
2. Find a teacher who is willing to supervise your work. If you are working with an existing organization in the community (like Habitat for Humanity, or Lowcountry Food Bank), you must contact them, and arrange for someone in that group/nonprofit/organization to supervise your work.
3. Submit it for approval to the SOA Credential Committee.
4. Once approved, you are expected to get other students from SOA involved in that project.
5. You must advertise your project via posters, and/or announcements at school, on the school website, or through facebook. Documentation proving advertisement should be submitted to the SOA Credential Committee.
6. On the day of the project, you need to take pictures/video of the group you recruited to help, along with pictures of them doing the work, and those must be submitted to the SOA Credential Committee also.
7. Complete and submit a service project report to the SOA Credential Committee on or before the due date for service logs. Your report should detail project parameters, benefits to the community as a result of the project, and should include all the evidence required above.
