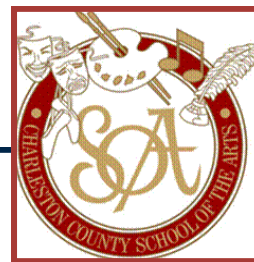


Choice Application for the 2021 - 2022 School Year

Theatre Virtual Audition

Dear Parents,

This year all auditions for the School of the Arts Theatre Department will be held live on Zoom. The Zoom link is provided below based on grade levels. We ask you not to share this link with anyone.

Prior to your student's audition you should do the following:

- Log into Zoom with your *student's Zoom account*.
- If you are able, please make sure that your student's display name on Zoom is their first name only.
- On the day of their audition, please make sure your student logs into Zoom and clicks on the link approximately 10 minutes prior to their scheduled audition time.
- Your student should have their laptop/Chromebook set up on a desk, table, or counter so that we are able to see their whole body.
- Make sure that your student has ample room around them, with at least 5-10 feet behind them - they will be moving around.
- Please write the student's first name, grade applying for and School Choice ID# (will be sent to you via email). Hold this up facing the camera and tell them your name, grade applying for and number.

During the Zoom Audition, students will be asked to complete the following tasks:

1. Present a prepared monologue - this is a memorized piece, 30 seconds to one minute long demonstrating the ability to create a character, monologues will be evaluated the believability of the character, stage creativity, and evidence of preparation. See website for example monologues.
2. Structured Improvisation - demonstrate the ability to focus, take direction, and express creativity.
3. Cold Reading - read aloud an unfamiliar passage using expression.
4. Question & Answer Session
