

SOA Auditions FAQ's

Due to the high volume of phone calls, it is best to utilize any answers you may find below before calling the school.

Train: If you get caught by the train, the directions link also has a map that can find a work around that stopped train (check this out before you head to the audition)!

Audition Locations: All in person auditions and callbacks will check in at the **Rose Maree Myers Theater Lobby** EXCEPT for Saturday, March 4th and Friday, March 17th. On these dates, you will check in at the main reception area in building 8 (flagpole in front).

Art Auditions set up:

ZOOM: Creative Writing & Visual Arts

VIDEO submission & CALLBACKS: Dance & Piano

IN PERSON: Band, Fashion, Strings, and Theater

IN PERSON & CALLBACKS: Vocal

How to find Audition Time (if you lost your email):

- Go to the [School Choice](#) page and login to your account and click on the parent dashboard to see your child's scheduled times.

CALLBACKS: *You will receive a phone call for call backs.*

Vocal:

- Call back date: Tuesday, March 21. 10am for 6th grade, 11am for 7-12 grade
- You will receive an email by the end of the day on March 9 if you have been invited for call backs, unless you have a make-up audition scheduled on March 20.

Dance:

- Call backs have been scheduled for Friday, March 10 & Saturday, March 11.
- We will send out an email notification to those who didn't receive a callback audition within the next day or two.

Piano:

- Call backs have been scheduled for Friday, March 10 & Saturday, March 18
- We will send out an email notification to those who didn't receive a callback audition within the next day or two.

MAKE UP AUDITIONS: *(sick, emergencies)*

- If you or your child needs to schedule a make-up audition, please call the front desk at 843-529-4990 and leave them your child's first and last name and the major they need to reschedule along with your phone number & email address. We will reschedule it for you and send you the new audition date and time.
- We will not be holding audition make ups after March 22.

RESULTS RELEASE DATE: CCSD will release school choice results for the entire school district on Monday, April 3rd.

I received a text to check my email:

- If you received a text to check your email, but you do not have an email, it means the email is either in your junk folder, or you did not select the box to receive both email and text messages when you first registered on the school choice platform. To fix your preferences, login to your account on the [School Choice](#) page and click Enable Email Notifications.

Student Choice Number: If you cannot locate the email that was sent with your child's School Choice ID number, you can call the front desk at 843-529-4990. This is only needed for creative writing and visual art auditions.

ZOOM AUDITIONS:

- If you cannot find your zoom link, you can call the front desk and let them know your audition major and time and they can email you the link again. *Please note - due to the high volume of calls and the business of the front reception area, it is best to do a search in your email to find the zoom link first before calling the school.*
- If you are in the waiting room of a zoom and you have not been let in yet, please do not worry. Our teachers are monitoring the room and will allow you in once they are ready to start. Sometimes there is a small delay
- How to change your screen name (must have FIRST NAME ONLY & student ID #): [edit profile on zoom](#)
- We STRONGLY suggest logging in and setting up your zoom session a minimum of 30 minutes before start time so you can solve any technical issues on your end.
- Visual Arts Zoom- 2 screen option?: *Someone asked if they could use two devices so they could look at one device and use the "look at me" camera on the other. A good example of this would be using a device with a large screen to look at the drawing, while using an iPhone with a camera so we can watch you draw. I have no problems with this - just make sure your devices are named with your name + your school choice number when you enter the zoom, and simply add "D2" to the name of the second device.*
- Visual Arts Zoom- Pin the Still Life: It will make it easier on your student if you "pin" the still life screen during the audition session. It can vary by device how to "pin": *I held my finger on the image for a moment in order to get it to pin on my iPhone, and I'm guessing the same thing will work on an iPad. On the mac/PC I put the mouse arrow over the image and a blue rectangle with*

dots popped up in the upper right hand corner. Select that rectangle and you should see "Pin" somewhere in the drop down menu.
