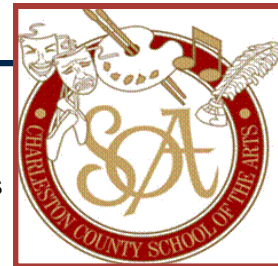


Choice Application for the 2021-2022 School Year

9th—12th Grade Costume and Fashion Design Audition Requirements

Students must be passing all academic subjects to apply to SOA



Costume and Fashion Design Virtual Audition

Dear Parents,

This year all auditions for School for the Arts Costume and Fashion Design will be virtual. It is a two part process starting with a portfolio submission, followed by a 30 minute Zoom audition.

Part 1 Audition (Portfolio Submission) - Must be submitted by 3 PM on March 5, 2021

- Create three drawings in color on paper of original costume or fashion designs appropriate for a child, teen or adult (male or female) on a human figure/model (croquis - see helpful links re: croquis at bottom of page).
- 1 garment either constructed or altered by student. Accessories may also be included.
- Portfolio of drawings and garment are to be dropped off at the Reception Area of School of the Arts between the hours of 8:00 AM and 3:30 PM.
 - ◆ Address: 5109 West Enterprise St., North Charleston, SC 29405. Use the sidewalk near the flagpole for the entrance to the Reception Area.
 - ◆ If you have difficulty getting your garment and sketches to the school, please email kelly_martin@charleston.k12.sc.us so we can make accommodations.
- Portfolio & Garment can be picked up between March 29th - April 2nd during office hours (8:00 AM - 3:30 PM) - Items not picked up will not be saved.
- LABELING SUBMISSIONS:
 - ◆ Student First Name ONLY (do not include last name), Student School Choice ID # (will be sent to you), and phone/email on every single submission:
 - ◇ Color Drawings: Place the three drawings in color in a manila folder with first name, ID # and phone/email
 - ◇ Garment: First name, ID #, and phone/email MUST be written on paper and pinned to each garment.

Part 2 Audition via Zoom Link (30 minutes)

Click on this [Zoom Link](#) 10 minutes before your scheduled audition time. Passcode is 475991

At the beginning of the zoom audition, student will need to have a piece of paper with their first name and School Choice ID# (will be sent to you via email). Designers will state their names while they show the paper to the camera.

- 20 minute live Zoom session.
- Student will be asked to draw a garment on a fashion figure sketch (croquis) that they draw themselves during the live audition (see helpful links below). The color sketch will be based on a theme provided during the live audition. The camera will need to be set up in a way that the panel can see the work space and the student working for the entire 20 minutes.
- Materials needed (please have workspace set up and ready before zoom audition time):
 - ◆ Pencil
 - ◆ Black Artist Pen
 - ◆ Colored pencils or markers
 - ◆ 8.5 x 11 White paper
- 10 minute question and answer session about their work.
- Student will be expected to discuss their submitted portfolio & garment (see Part 1) and their live sketch they completed during the Zoom session.
