Strategic Goals

Student Achievement

- From June 2022 to June 2028, increase the percent of students scoring Meets or Exceeds on SC Ready ELA from 55.7% to 64.6% for all students, and 18.2% to 34.6% for African American students.
- From June 2022 to June 2028, increase the percent of students scoring Meets or Exceeds on SC Ready Math from 50.1% to 60.1% for all students, and 13.3% to 30.6% for African American students.
- By June 2028, increase the percent of grade 8 students scoring a C or higher on the Algebra 1 End-of-Course exam by the end of 8th grade from 24.2% to 66.4%.
