Late In / Early Out Application Form

Late Ins and Early Outs are privileges for **Seniors** in good standing with West Ashley High and who are on schedule to meet **ALL** graduation requirements at the end of the school year.

Late In / Early Out Rules:

1. Students **CANNOT** be on campus prior to 10 minutes before their first class.
2. Student **CANNOT** loiter in a teacher's classroom during the time of their Late In or Early Out
3. Students **MUST** leave campus immediately after their last class.
4. Students **MUST** have their Late In / Early Out badge to leave campus.
5. Students are **NOT** allowed to loiter in the Student Parking Lot after arriving at school.
6. Students are **NOT** allowed to enter the building until the bell rings for class change.
7. Schedules will **NOT** be adjusted to accommodate Late Ins / Early Outs.
8. Students **MUST** be on track to fulfill graduation requirements (**must be college and/or career ready**).
9. Students **MUST** have fees paid and return all outstanding textbooks.
10. In order to receive a Late In or Early Out, students **MUST** complete and turn in this form to the School Counseling Office on or before **Friday, May 6, 2022 by 3:00 p.m.**
11. Student attendance and discipline from second semester will be used to determine *initial* 2022-2023 approval (**including 1/19/22-5/6/22**). Attendance and discipline through **6/2/22** will be used for **final** approval.

By signing below, I agree to follow the rules listed above. I acknowledge that a violation of these rules may result in disciplinary action. I understand that repeated violations will result in the LOSS of my Late In or Early Out privileges. Parents are encouraged to take a photo or keep a copy of the application before submission.

Any NEWLY enrolled senior to (WAHS) for the 22-23 school year can be considered for Late in/Early out if the College/Career Readiness Criteria is met. The application deadline date above are for current WAHS students.
